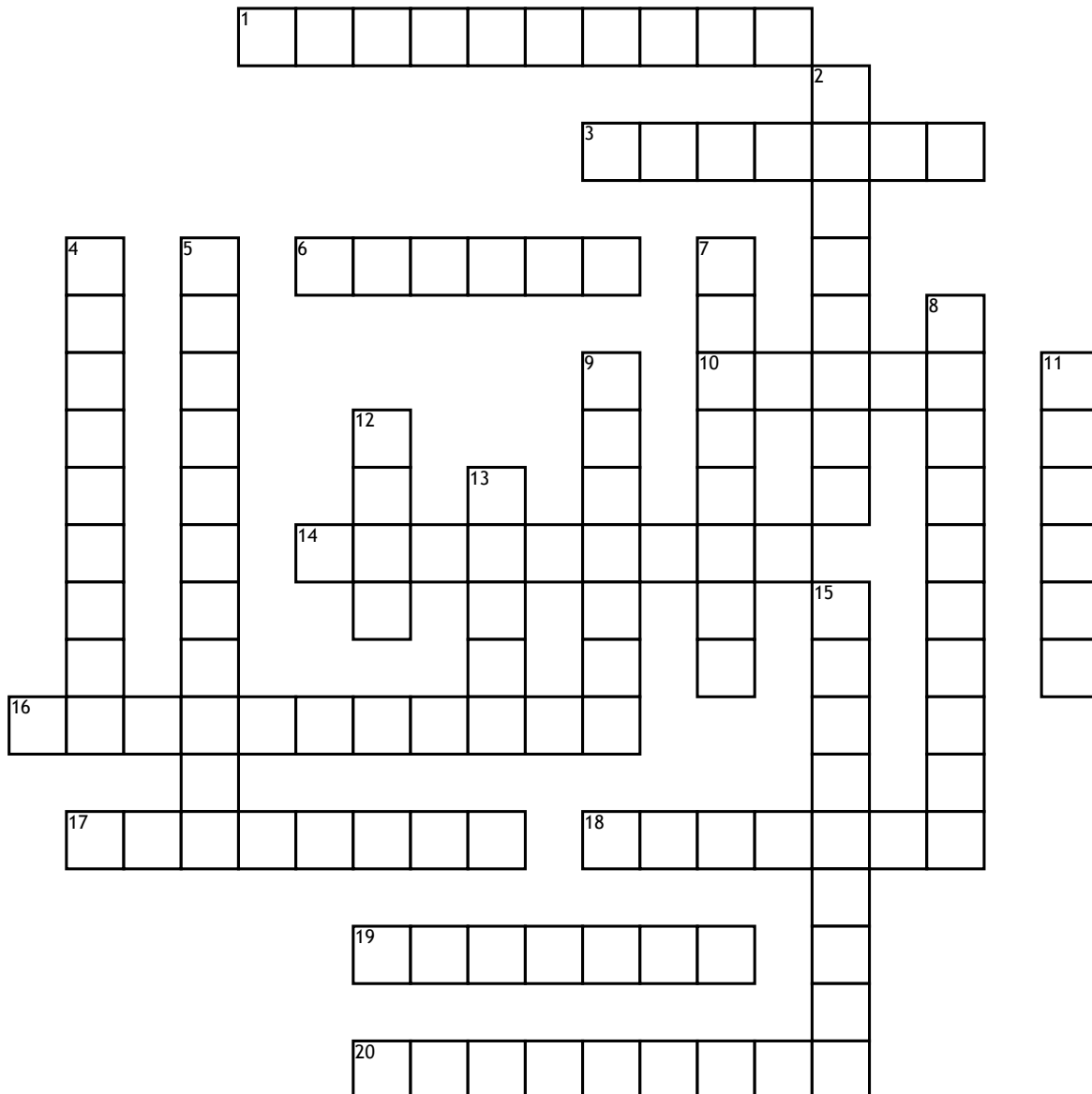


# Vocab Unit 2 Crossword Puzzle
