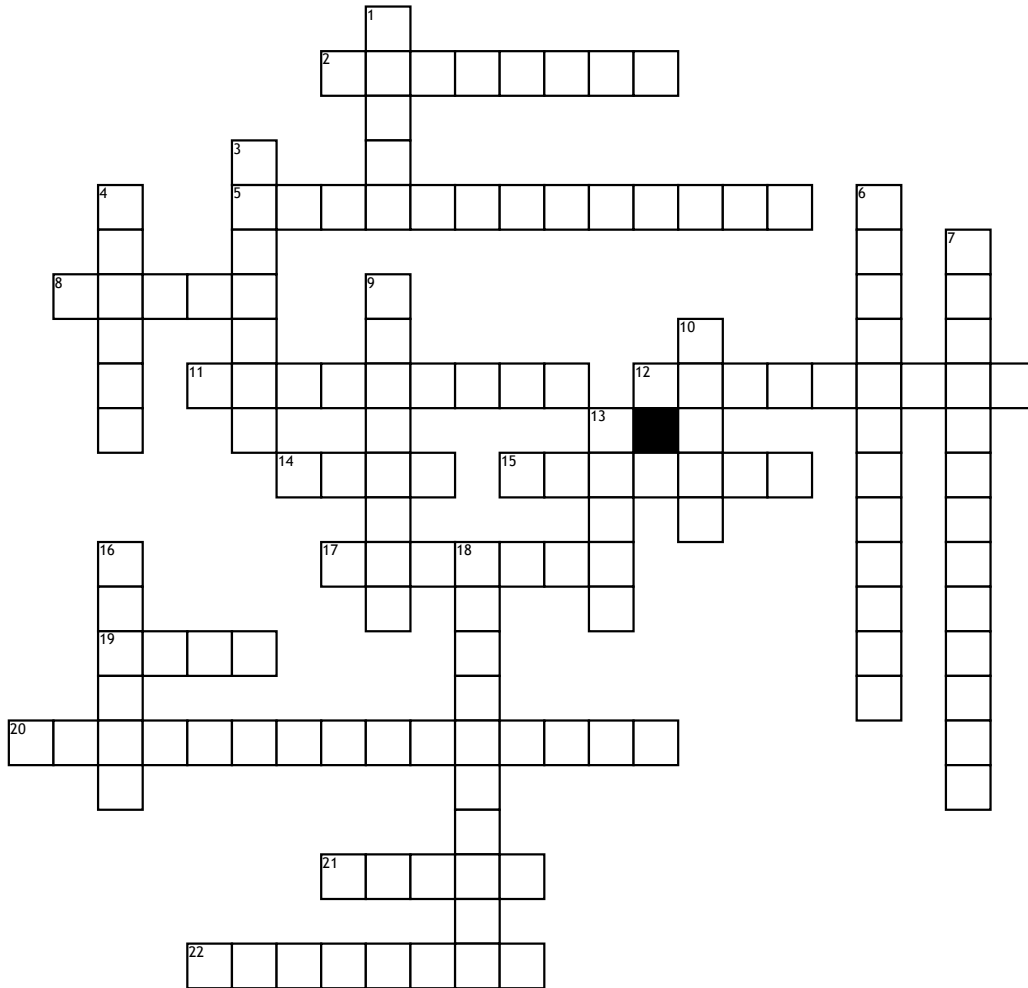

- 2. an agreement between God and his people, in which God makes promises to his people and, usually, requires certain conduct from them.
- 5. the path to nirvana, comprising eight aspects in which an aspirant must become practiced: right views, intention, speech, action, livelihood, effort, mindfulness, and concentration.
- 8. a collection of hymns and other ancient religious texts written in India between about 1500 and 1000 BCE.
- 11. the saving of the soul from sin and its consequences.
- 12. a religious ceremony or ritual regarded as imparting divine grace.
- 14. the Bishop of Rome, and thereby the world leader of the Catholic Church. 10. Reincarnation-after death a person's soul is reborn in another body.
- 15. a member of the highest, or priestly, class among the Hindus. Compare Kshatriya, Shudra, Vaisya
