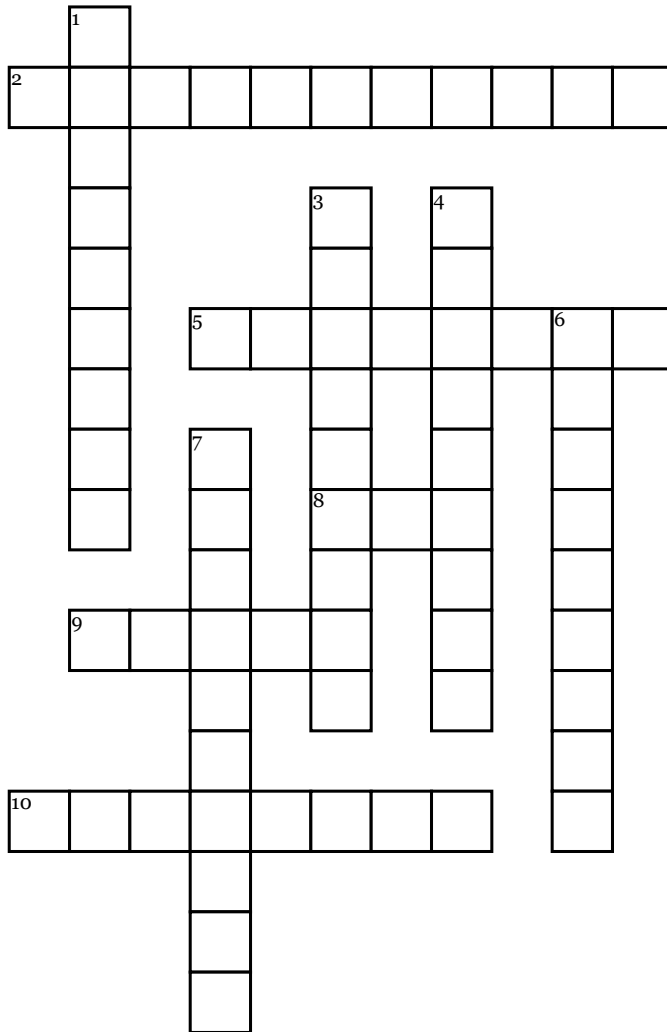


# Vocabulaire de Mardi Gras

- 1.** An item of jewelry that is worn around the neck.
- 3.** This dish consists of a mix of meat –chicken, seafood, or sausage and peppers, onions, other vegetables, spices and rice combined in multiple ways.
- 4.** Small pieces of colored plastic with a hole through the middle put together on a piece of string or wire to make jewelry.
- 6.** A square piece of dough, fried and covered with powdered sugar. Sometimes it's filled with fruit.
