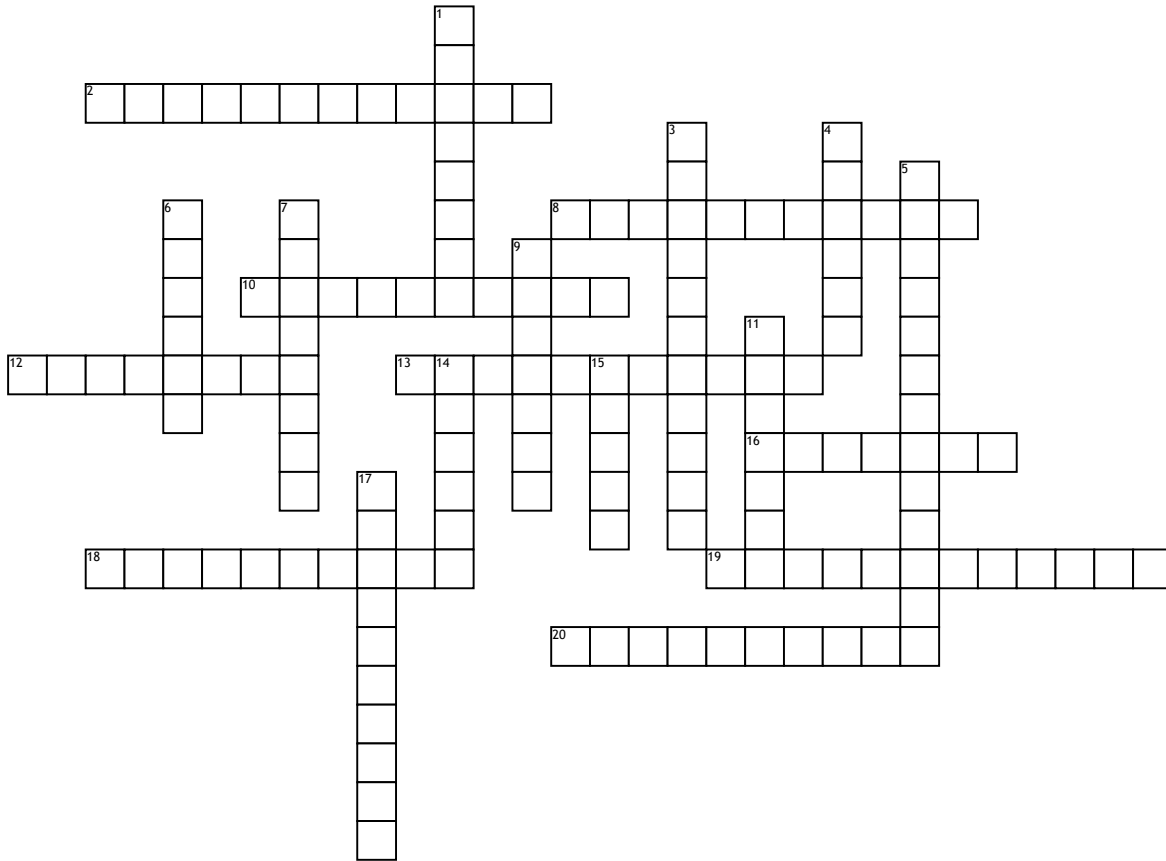


Vocabulary Cross-Word Puzzle
