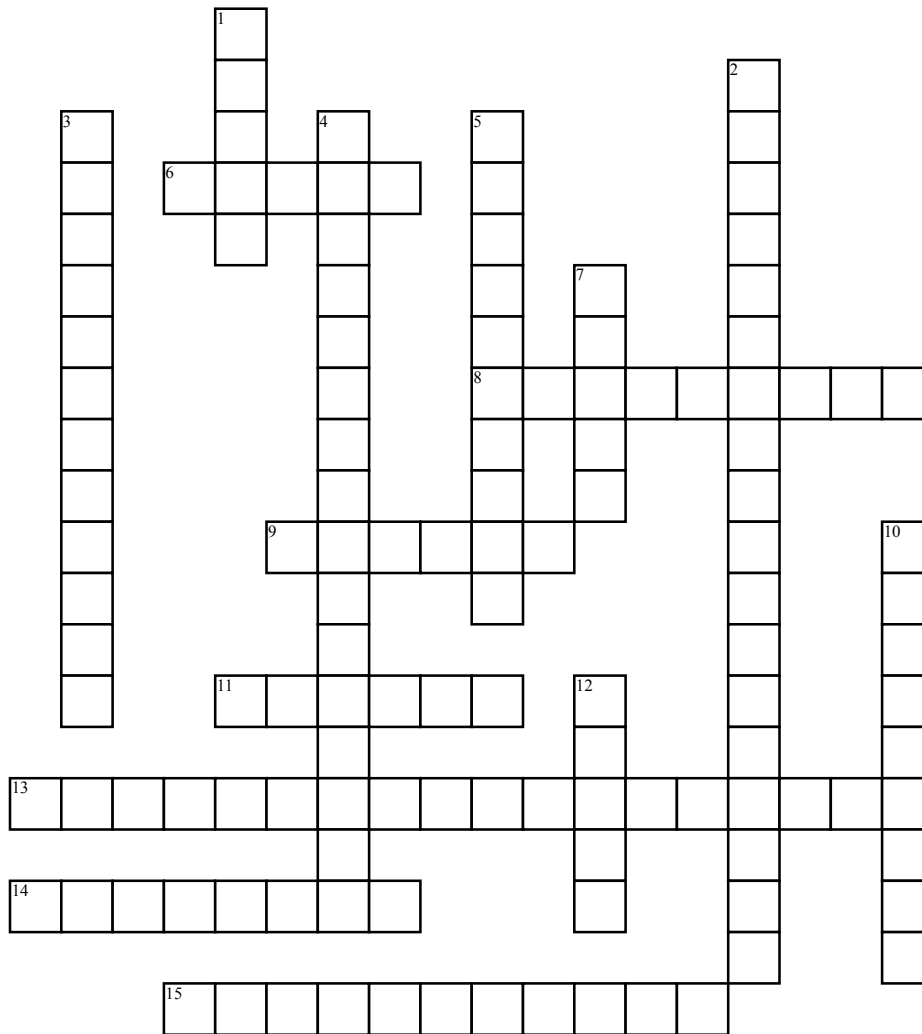


# Vocabulary crosswords
