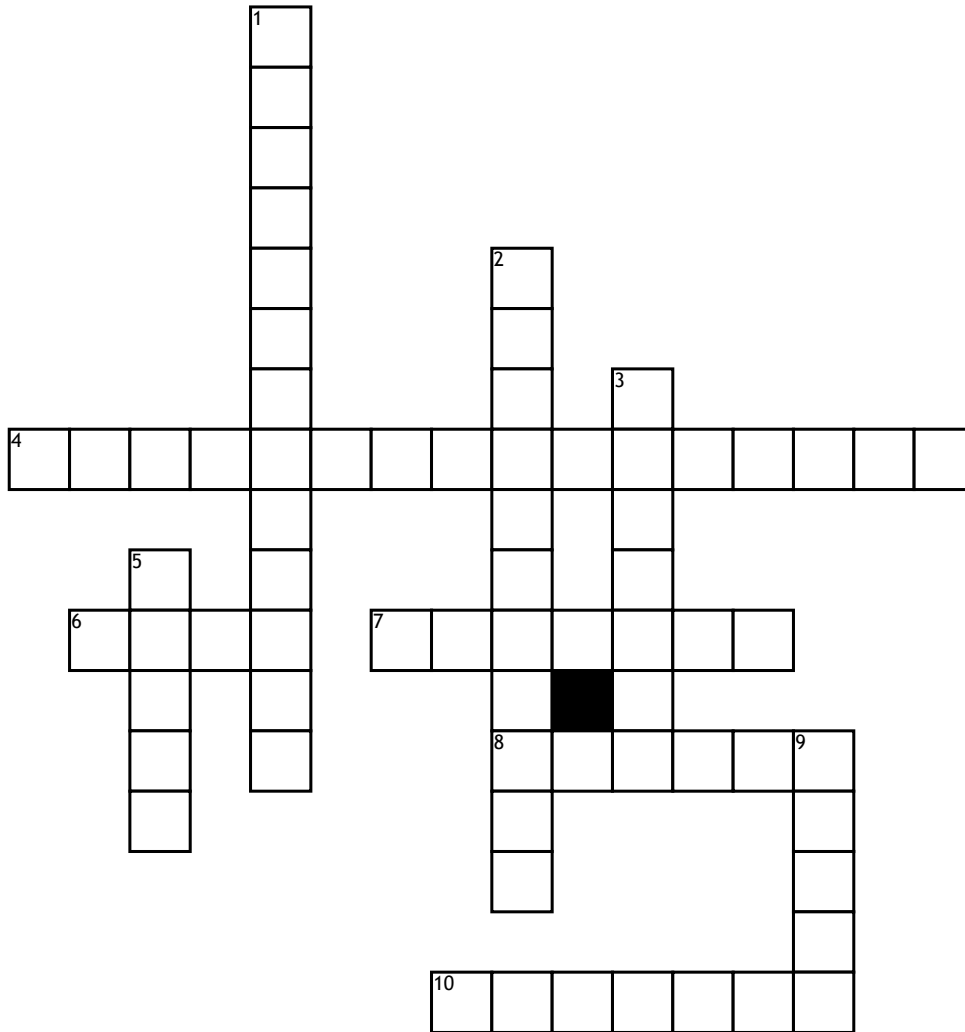

1. Low to the ground, broad dome-shaped mountain. Appearing like an umbrella top on the ground.
2. Also known as cinder cone, the lava piles up and creates triangle-shaped volcanoes.
3. Have not erupted in a long time, but could erupt again. Called sleeping volcanoes.
5. Hot melted rock (molten liquid) under the Earth's crust.
9. When pressure builds, ash, rocks, gases, and steam escape by oozing or exploding.
