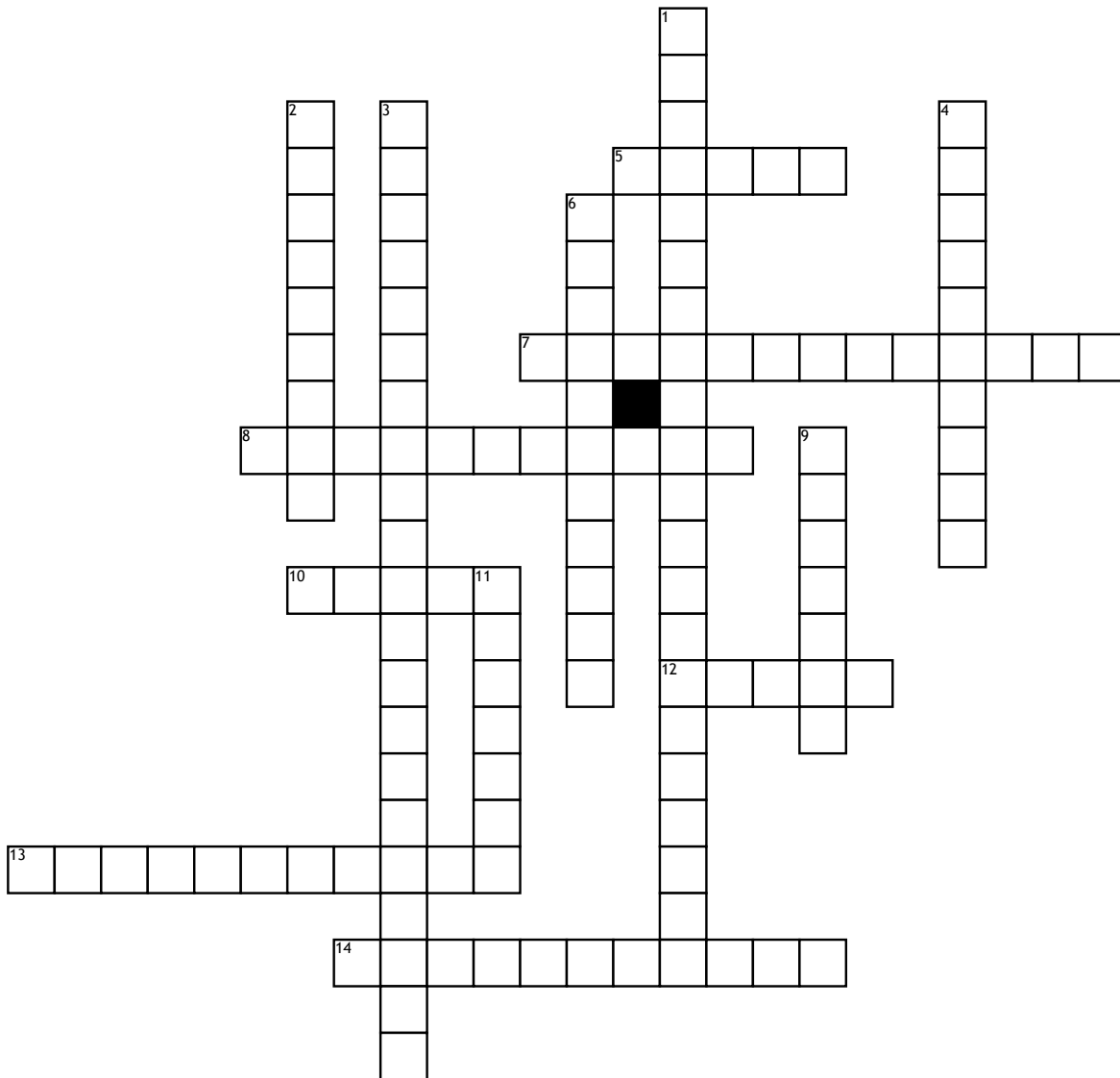


# Voluntary manslaughter

- 5. D stabbed his girlfriend 60 times, killing her
- 7. This partial defence is defined in section 54 of the coroners and justice act 2009
- 8. D savagely attacked a man resulting in death, whilst he was in a drunken state. He also suffered from a mental abnormality, adjustment disorder which was a depressed grief reaction following the death of his aunt

- 10. D killed his partner & admitted the killing. The medical evidence showed he had an abnormality of mental functioning arising from a medical condition.
- 12. D, an alcoholic, having drunk nearly a bottle of vodka, strangled his 11 year daughter
- 13. The act created in 1957 to create a defence to avoid the death penalty
- 14. was replaced by loss of control in the C&J act 2009
