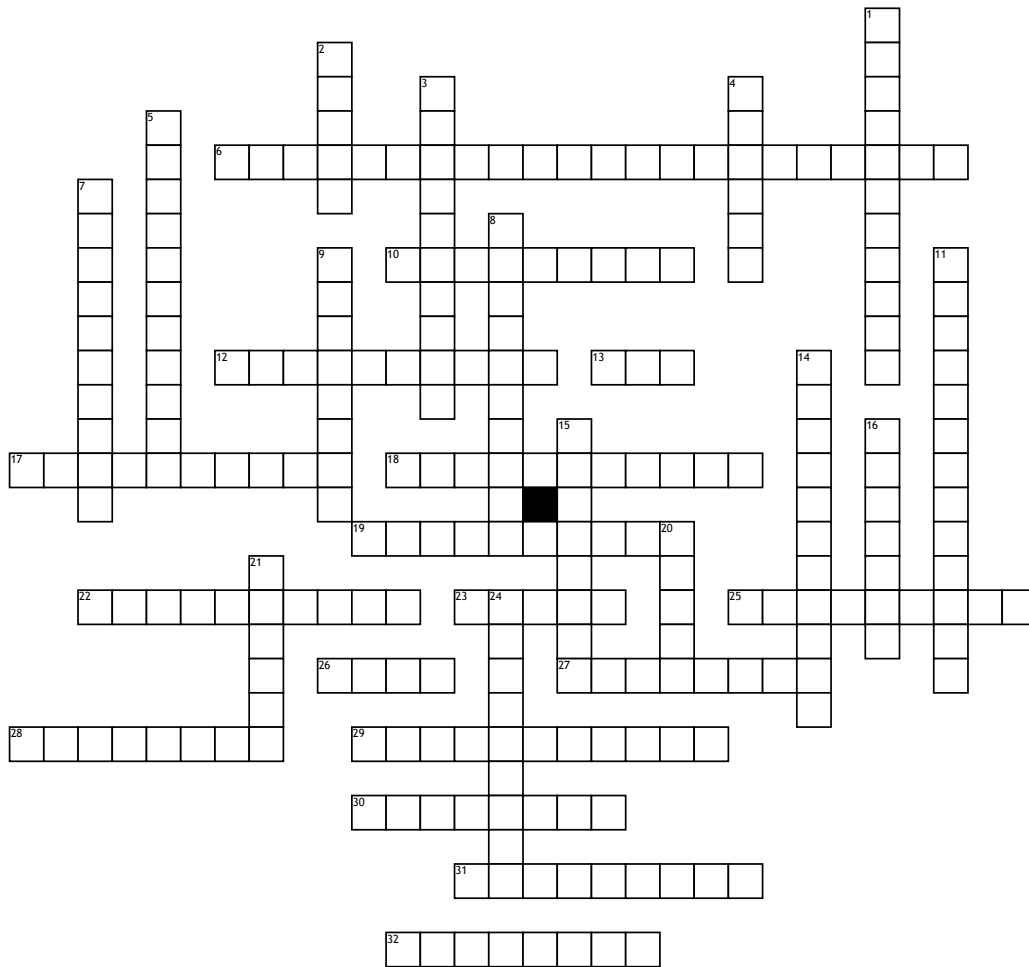


# WIN! Program Crossword Puzzle
