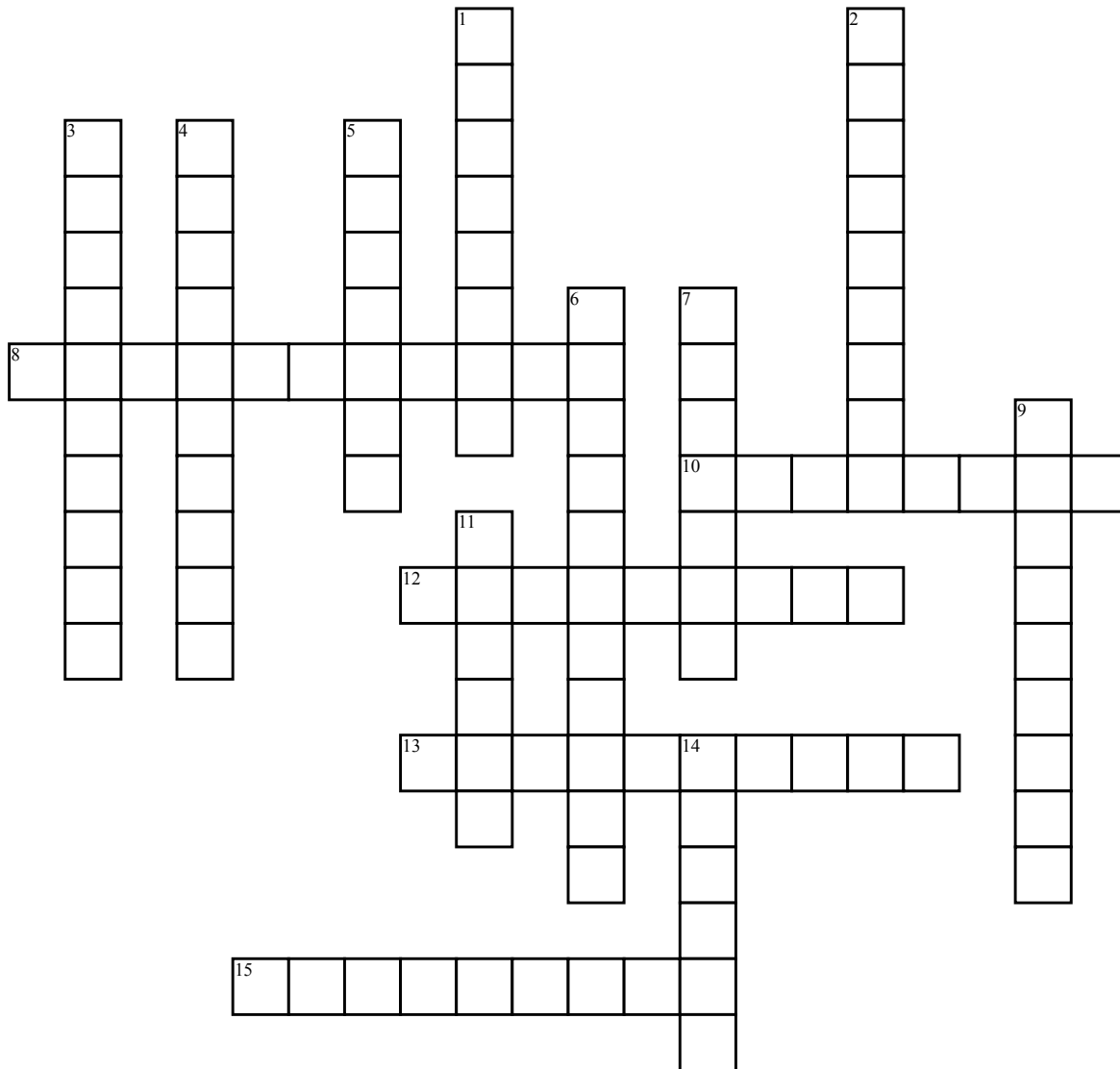


# WW1 Cross Word Puzzle
