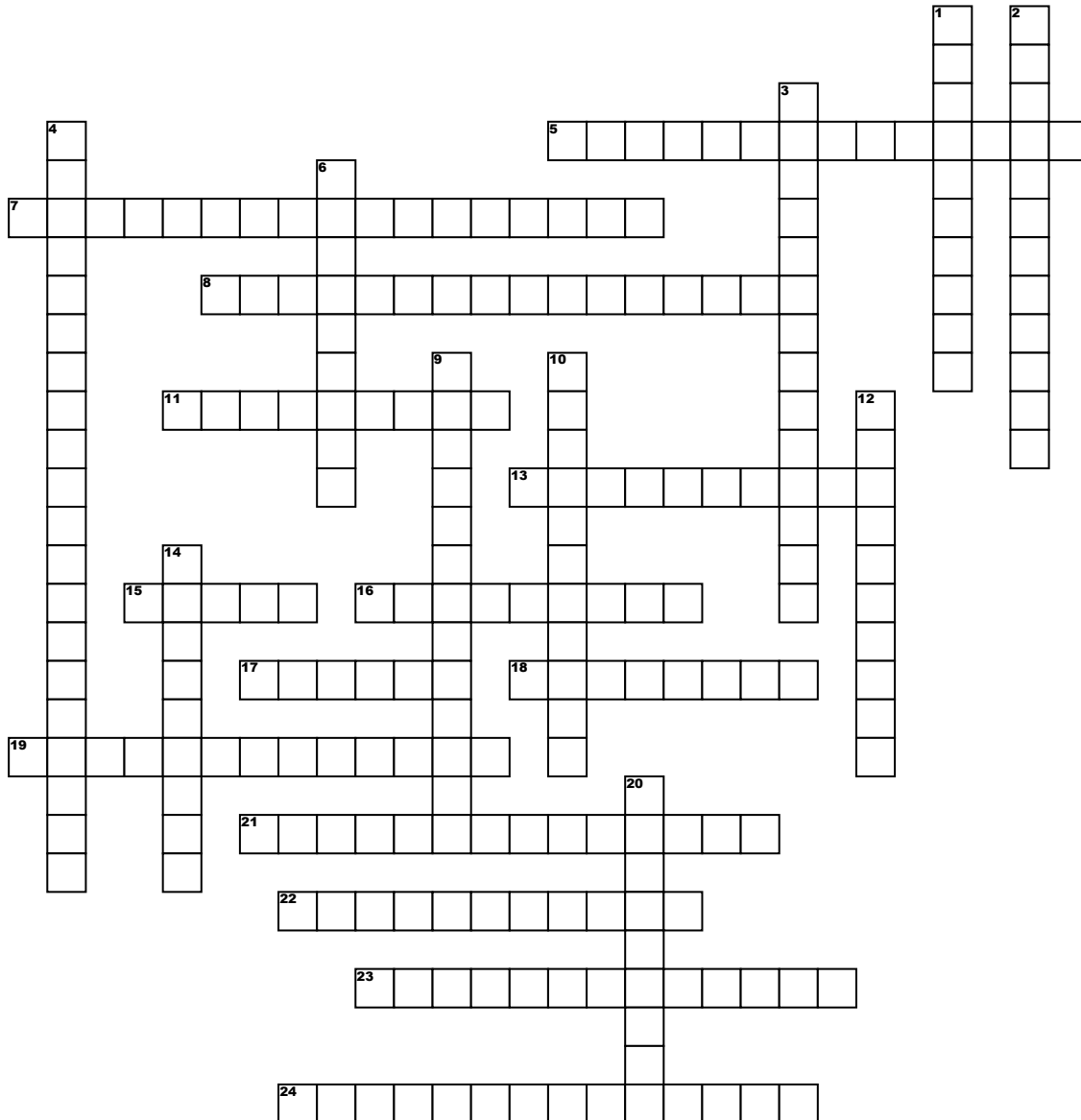

- 7. Prime Minister of France during WW1
- 8. final liberal to serve as British Prime Minister during and after WW1
- 11. a British ocean liner containing citizens that was sunk by a German U-Boat
- 13. the movement in the Balkans seeking independence from Austria-Hungary
- 15. battle of WW1 between Britain and Germany in 1916
- 16. the agreement in 1918 to officially end all battle in WW1
- 17. contained the longest battle of WW1 on the Western Front between France and Germany
- 18. unrestricted use of weapons, territory, or combatants

19. the US President that led America through WW1

- 21. the French cities taken over by Germany led by Otto Von Bismarck
 - 22. the British nurse that helped 200 allied soldiers escape Belgium
 - 23. the alliance that slowly evolved over the war, at first containing Germany and Austria-Hungary, but then brought in the Ottomans and Bulgaria

- 1. symbol for Austria-Hungary's ability to receive anything they needed from Germany
 - 2. the alliance built around the Triple Entente; contained Britain, Russia, Italy, France, and the US

- 3. a statement of principles of peace written by President Woodrow Wilson at the end of the war
- 4. peace treaty signed on March 3, 1918, officially ending Russia's participation in the war
- 6. Austria-Hungary's offer of necessities for Serbia to abide by
- 9. a proposed alliance between Germany and Mexico during the war
- 10. Germany and its allies payed \$33 billion to the allies for civilian damage
- 12. the space between two opposing trenches; essentially a death sentence to walk through
- 14. symbol for Europe in the early 20th century; needed a "spark"
