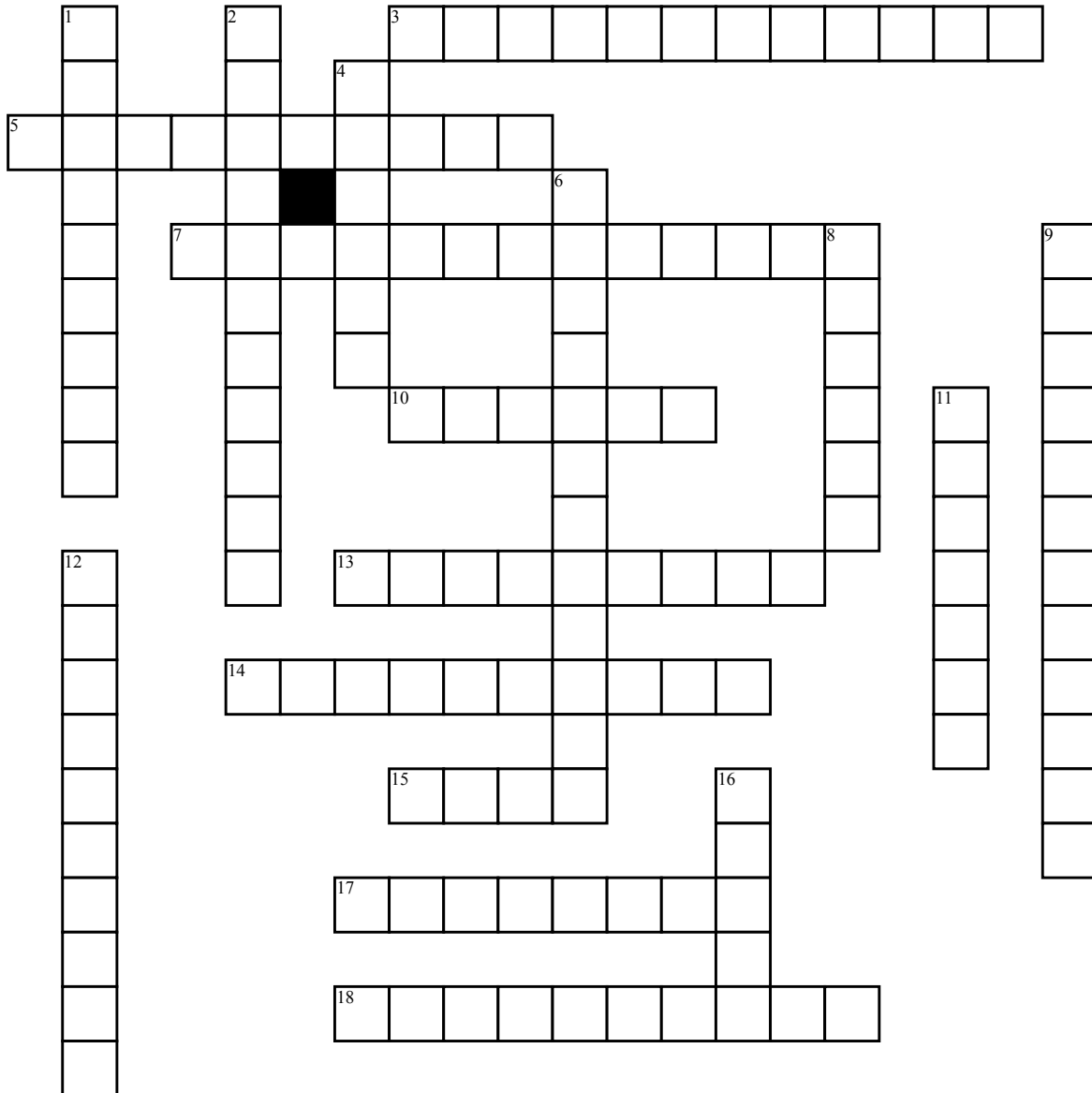


WW2 Crossword

- 3. the gathering of resources and preparation for war.
- 5. information, ideas, or rumors deliberately spread widely to help or harm a person, group, movement, institution, nation, etc.
- 7. those countries fighting against the Axis powers. i.e. Britain, France, USA, Canada, USSR etc.
- 10. Country conquered by the British in the 1870s and 1880s that offered ports that enabled the British navy to control sea lanes linking the Indian Ocean with the South China Sea. This country also provided abundant supplies of tin and rubber.
- 13. A methodical plan orchestrated by Hitler to ensure German supremacy. It called for the elimination of Jews, non-conformists, homosexuals, non-Aryans, and mentally and physically disabled.

- 4. The doctrines of nationalism, racial purity, anti-Communism, and the all-powerful role of the State. The National Socialist German Workers Party, otherwise known as the Nazi Party. Nazism was advocated by Adolf Hitler in Germany.

- 12. camps used under the rule of Hitler in Nazi Germany for the purpose of killing prisoners immediately.
