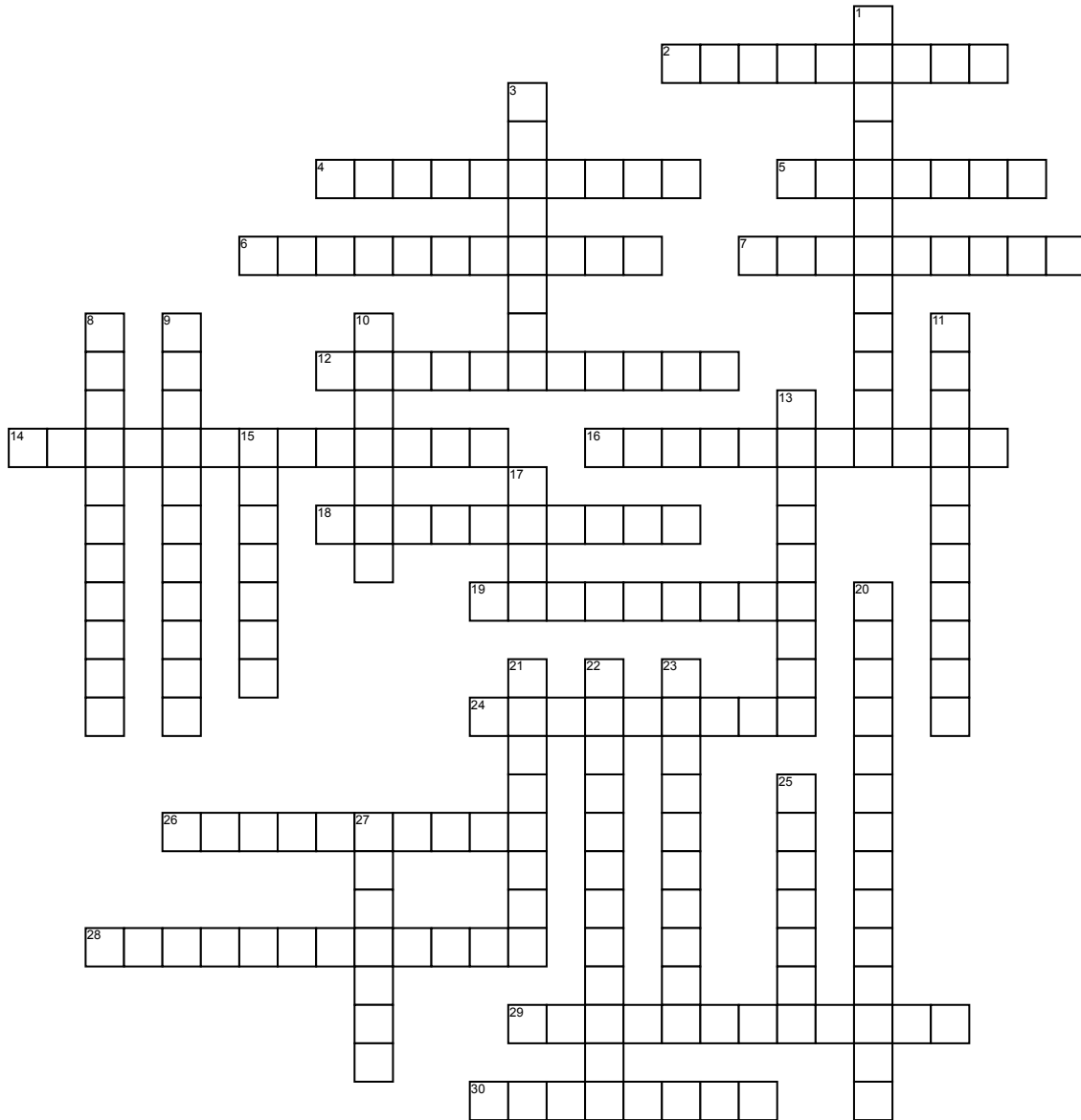


WWII Cangs Crossword Puzzle
