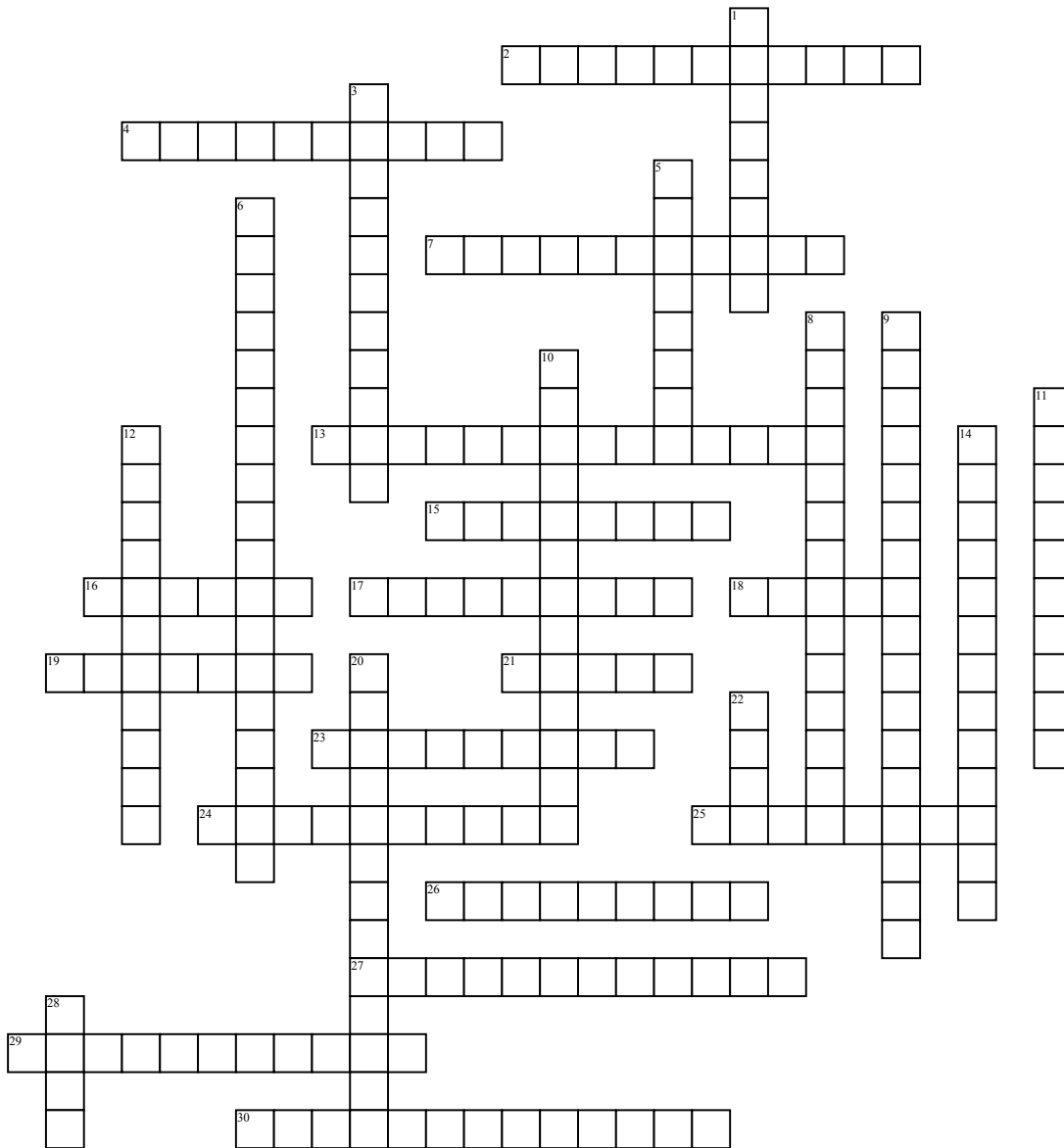


WWI & Roaring '20s Crossword Puzzle: Cang
