1. The income people get for the work they do,
 2. Money received, especially on a regular basis, for work
 3. A wage that provides only the bare necessities of life.
 4. A wage that is reasonable for the type of work done.
 5. Paid in terms of goods rather than cash.
 6. Wages paid by the hour
 7. Paid based on a predetermined annual amount.
 8. A possible payment at the end of the year or at Christmas time.
 9. Pay to encourage employees to achieve a higher standard.
 10. Most common is sales, where you are paid on percentage of sales met
 11. Paid for each piece of "work" you do
 12. Wage for working only 40 hours per week.
 13. Hourly rate times 1.5 for hours worked over 40 hours.
