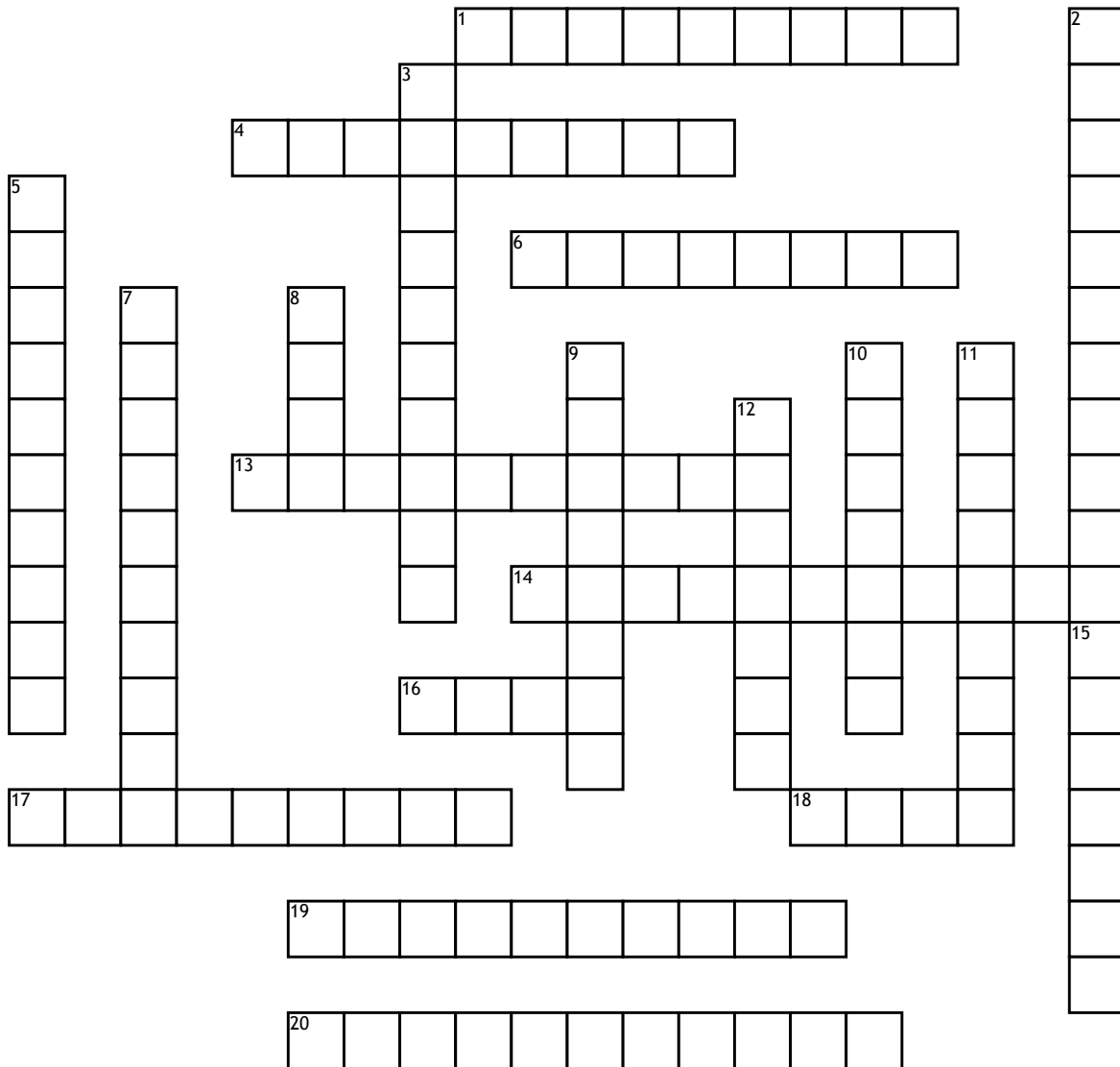

- 17. boundary of an advancing mass of warm air

- 2. front a pair of air masses neither of which is strong enough to replace the other
