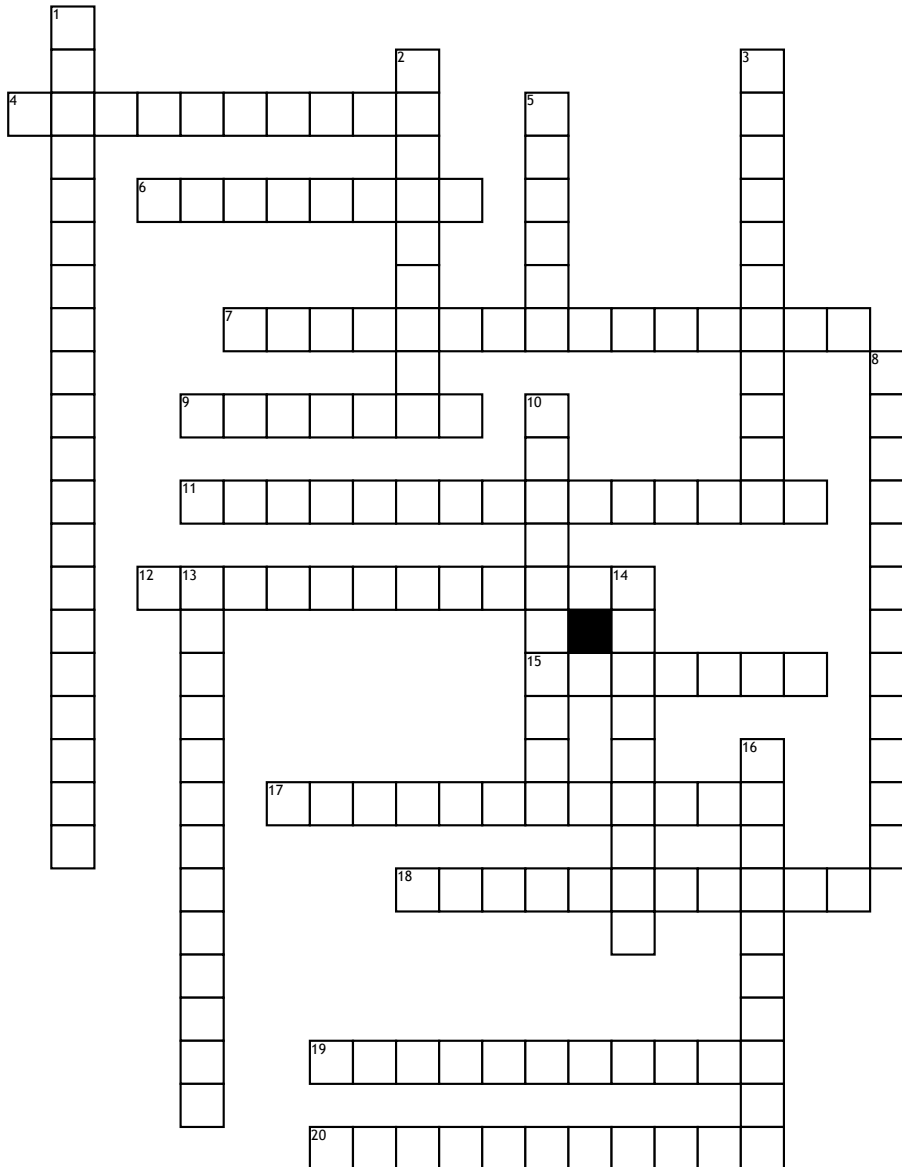


Weather Crossword
