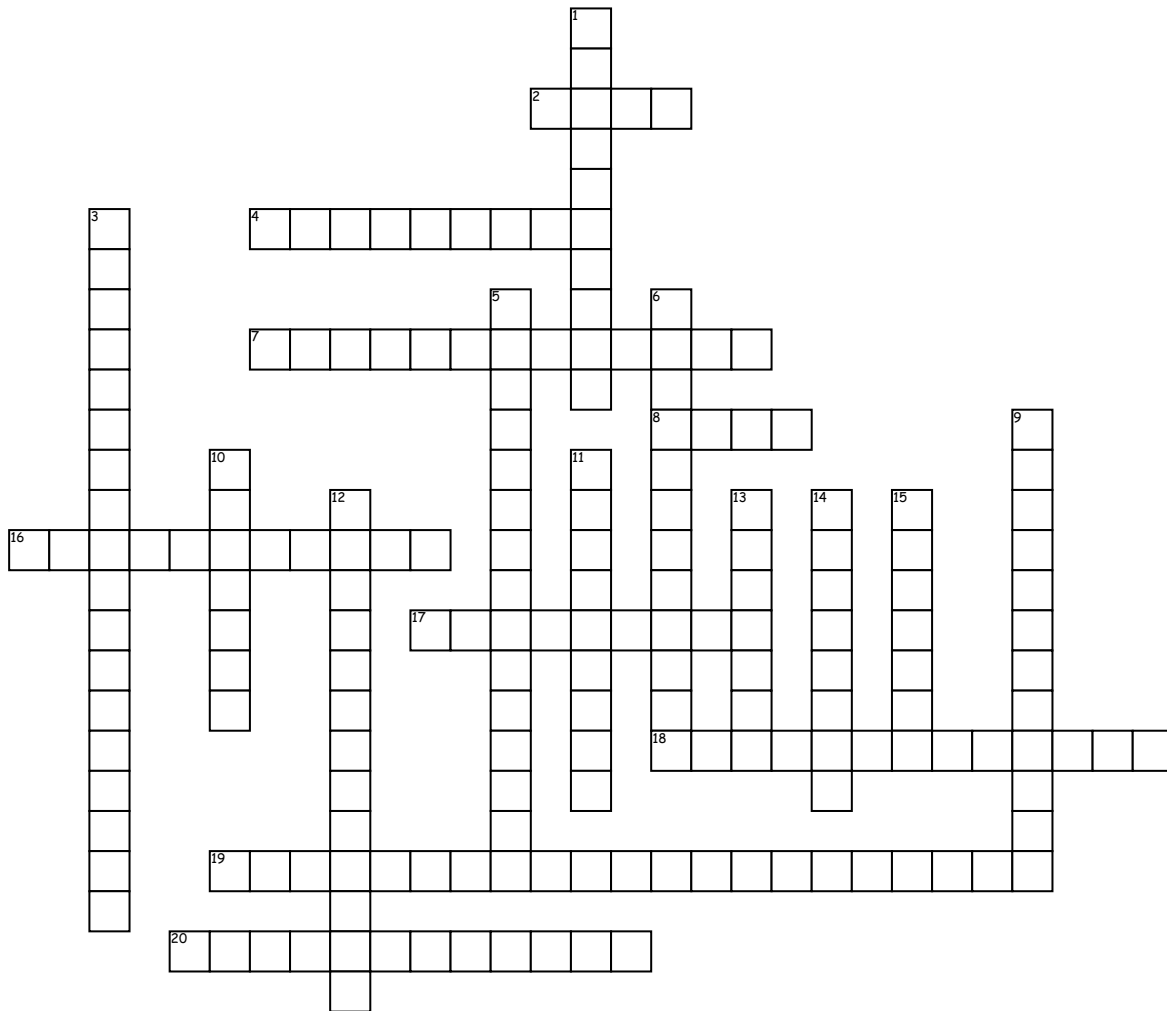

- 2. ice pellets falling from clouds when there are strong rising air currents

- 8. drops of fresh water that fall as precipitation from clouds
- 16. the measure of the amount of thermal energy in the atmosphere
- 17. is formed when a warm air mass pushes into a cold air mass, the boundary where a warm air mass moves over a cold air mass

18. smooth, gray clouds that cover the whole sky (block out direct sunlight). Light rain and drizzle can happen.

19. temperature, precipitation, wind, humidity, air pressure

20. a short, heavy storm that consists of rain, strong winds, lightning, and thunder

1. A map that shows data about recent weather conditions across a large area

3. large, fluffy, dark on the bottom. They may produce thunderstorms.

5. occurs when the air pressure is higher than areas around it; usually means cooler temperatures and drier weather

6. feathery clouds. fair weather. often indicate that rain or snow will fall soon.

9. dark gray rain clouds

10. a powerful funnel-shaped column of spiraling air that forms over land

11. when a cold air mass pushes under a warm air mass

12. fluffy and white with flat bottoms. They usually indicate fair weather.

13. the condition of Earth's atmosphere at a particular time and place

14. the amount of moisture in the air

15. a huge body of air that has similar temperature, humidity, and air pressure
