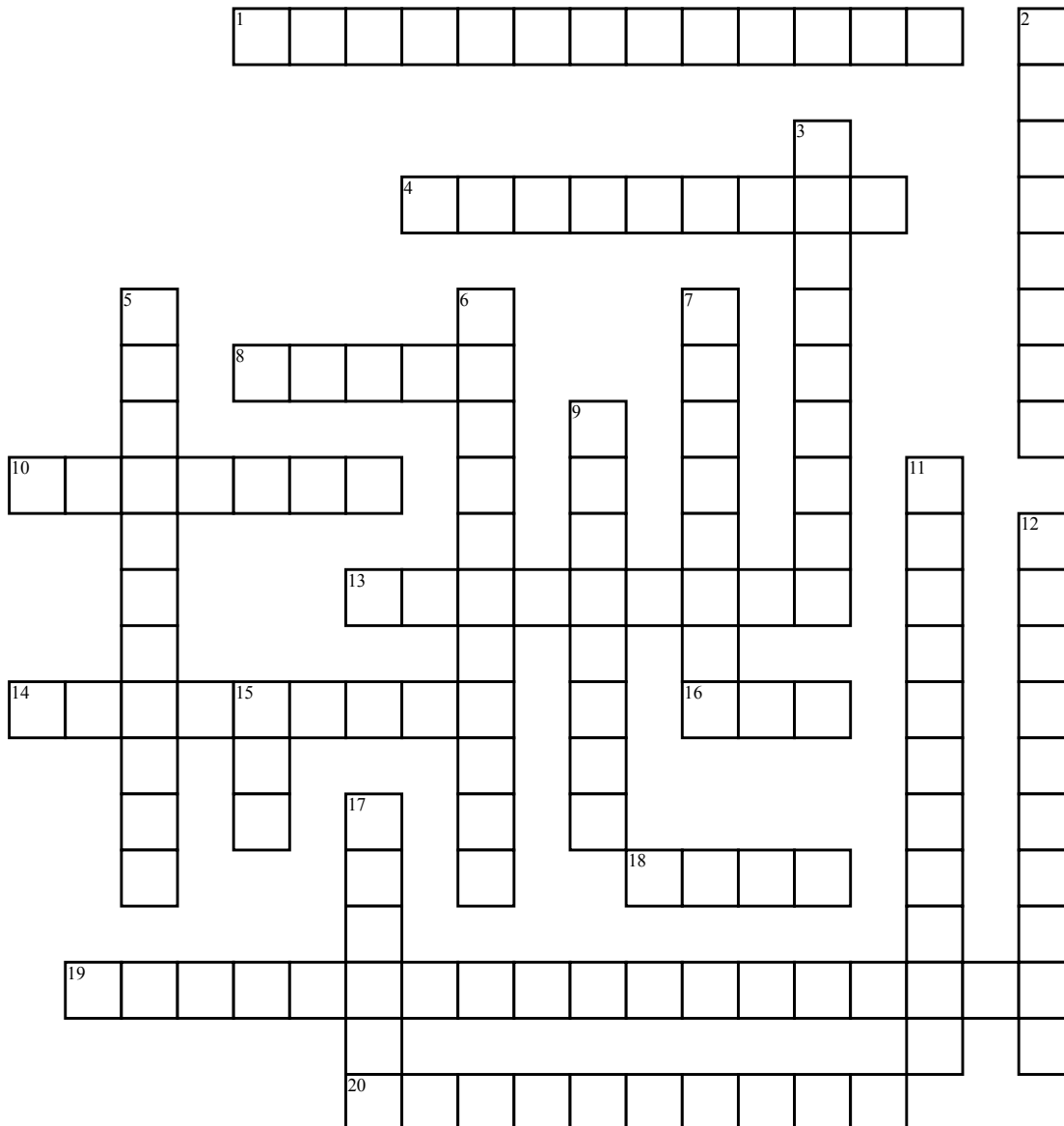


Weather climate

- 1. Any form of water that falls from the sky
- 4. Strong winds within a narrow band in the atmosphere

- 14. The leading edge of a warm air mass
- 16. Water that has condensed onto objects objects near the ground

- 20. Winds that occupy most of the tropics and blow from subtropical highs to equatorial lows

- 2. An instrument used to determine wind direction
- 3. A cylindrical container that measures rainfall
