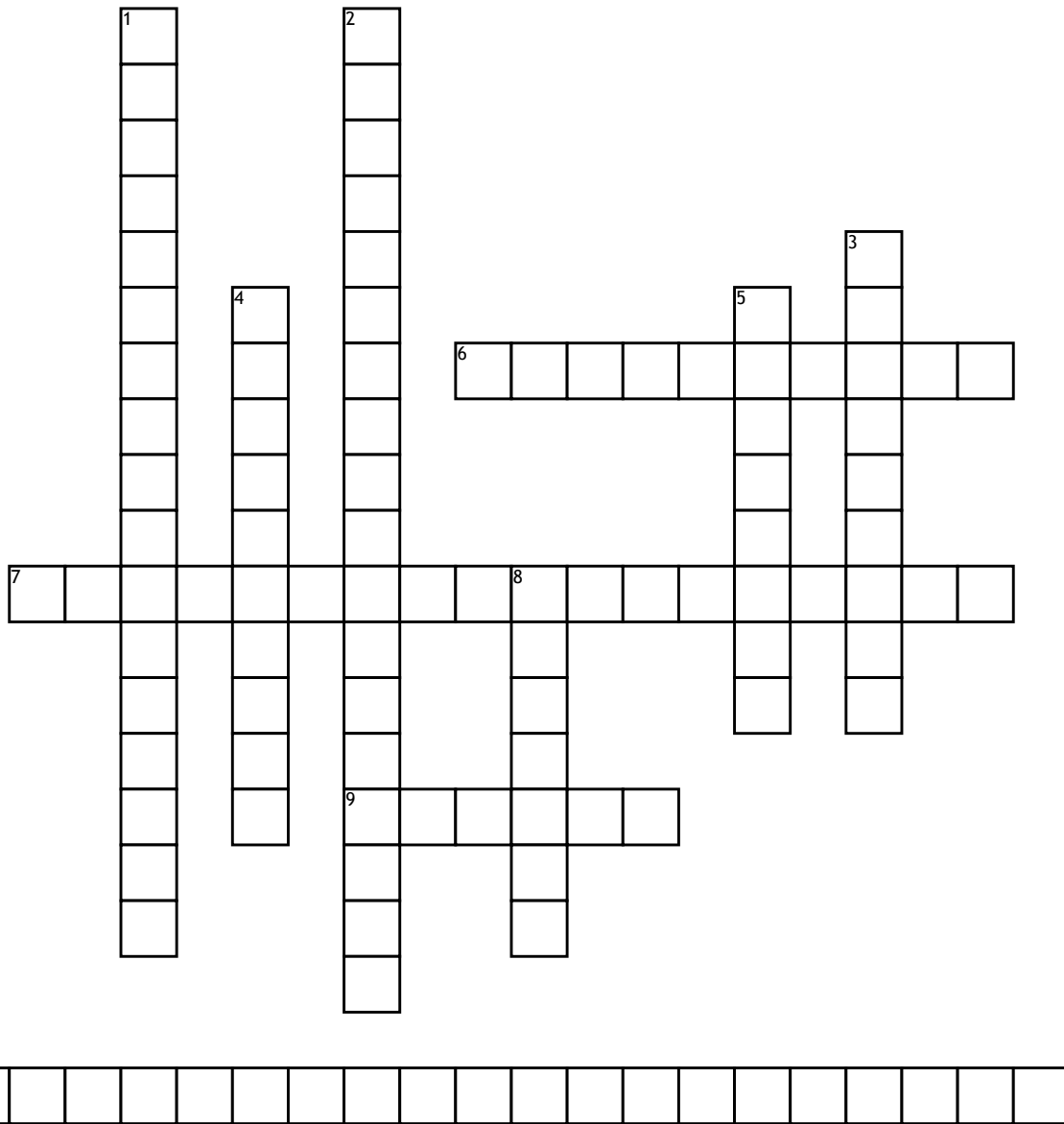


# Weathering
