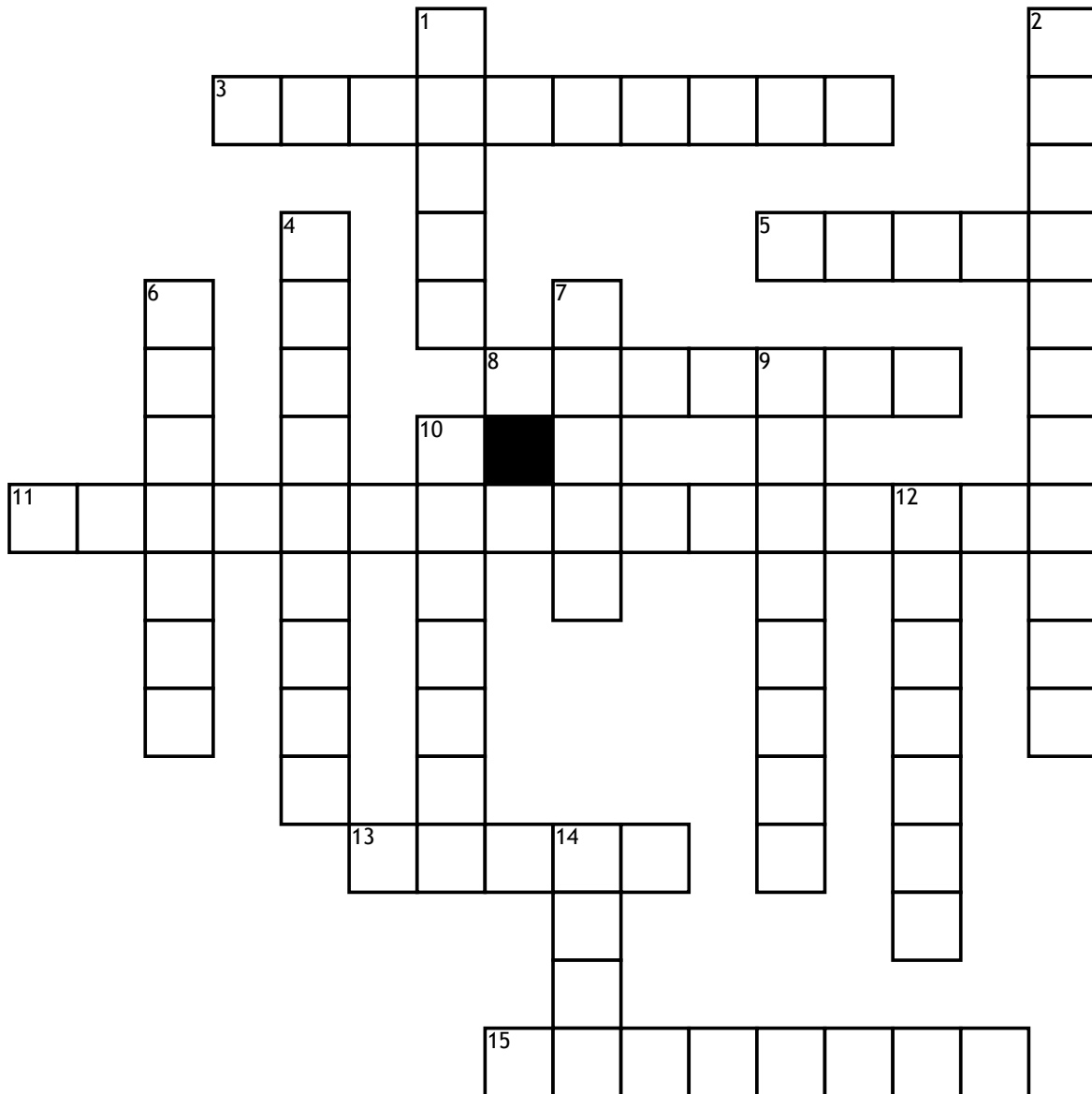


Weathering Erosion And Deposition

- 3. The geological process in which Sediments, soil and rocks are added to a land form or land mass
- 5. A sloping mass of rock fragments at the foot of a cliff
- 8. Material carried away from a glacier by melt water and deposited beyond the moraine
- 11. Moves parallel to the shore line
- 13. A triangular tract of sediment deposited at the mouth of a river, typically where it diverges into several outlets

- 15. A slowly moving mass or river of ice formed by the accumulation and compaction of snow on mountains or near the poles

- 1. A loosley compacted yellowish-grey deposit of windblown sediment of which extensive deposits occur
- 2. Slope movement or mass movement
- 4. The sliding down of a mass of earth or rock from a mountain or cliff
- 6. A series of curves and bends

- 7. A mound or ridge of sand or other loose sediment formed by the wind, especially on the sea coast or in a desert
- 9. The process of scraping and wearing down of rocks
- 10. A mass of rocks and sediment carried down and deposited by a glacier, typically as ridges at its edges or extremity
- 12. The process of eroding or being eroded by wind, water, or other natural agents
- 14. Unsorted glacial sediment
