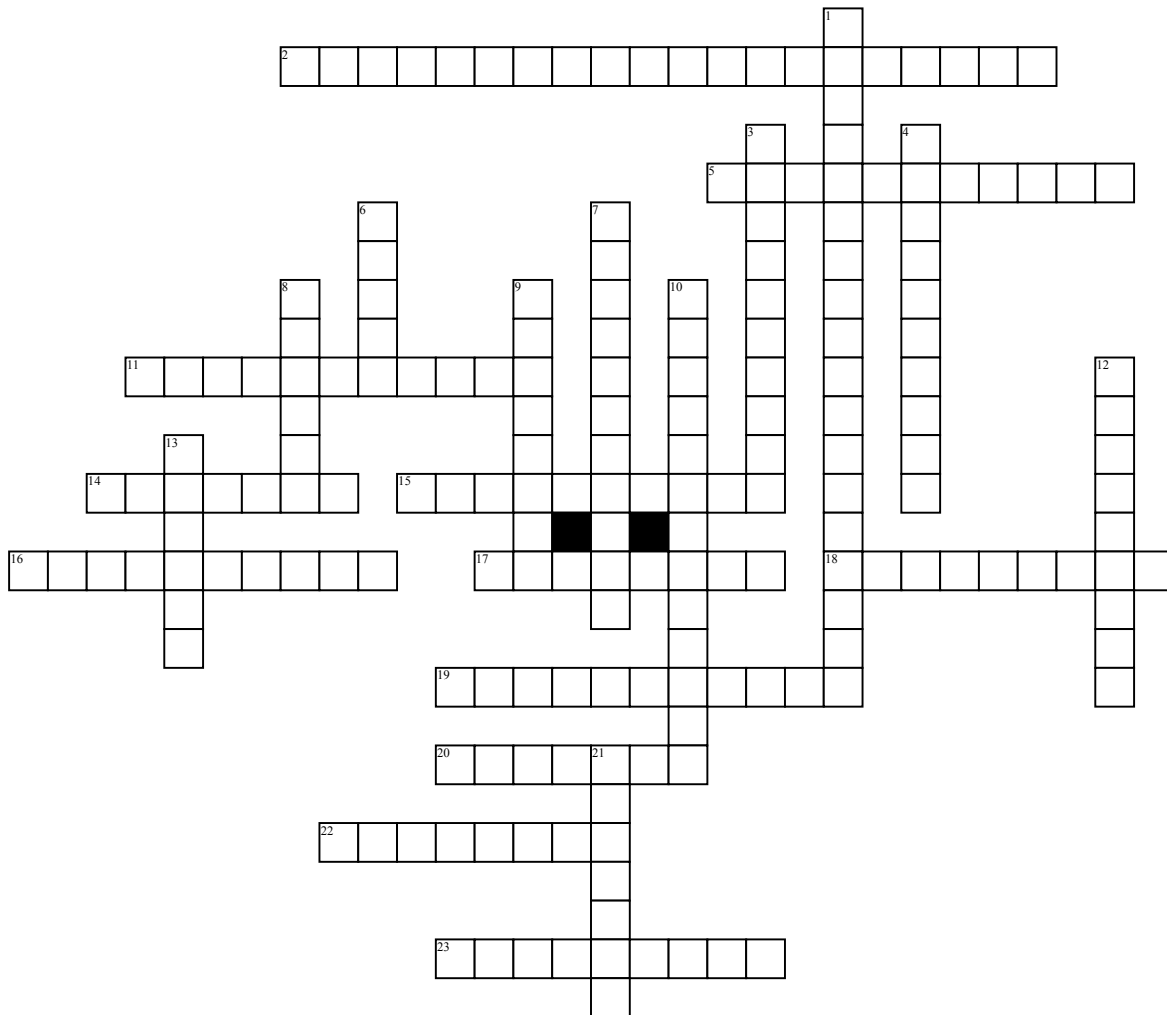


Weathering and Erosion

- 2. the breakdown of rock into smaller pieces by physical means
- 5. rock formed by deposition and compaction of sediment
- 11. a fan shaped mass of sediment deposited when water flows from a steep slope onto a flat plain
- 14. curve in a river created by erosion and deposition
- 15. the area of land surrounding a river that will be underwater when the river floods
- 16. breakdown of rocks caused by constant cycle of freezing and thawing
- 17. anything that falls out of wind or water
- 18. the cycle of processes that rocks undergo on earth's surface

- 19. movement of large amounts of sediment down hill
- 20. the carrying away of weathered sediment
- 22. the grinding and wearing away of a rock by other rocks or sand
- 23. Smaller stream or creek that flows into a larger river system

- 1. breakdown of rocks due to a change in chemical composition
- 3. the process of dropping weathered particles in another location
- 4. process by which rock is broken down into smaller pieces
- 6. deposit of sediment that forms at the mouth of a river
- 7. change in a rock due to extreme heat and pressure

- 8. high point where water flows to either side
- 9. forms when the roof of a cavern collapses because it's too thin
- 10. the low point of land that all surrounding water flows into
- 12. lake that has formed from a cut off meander
- 13. open area under the surface made from water wearing away limestone bedrock
- 21. rock that is formed from cooled magma/lava
