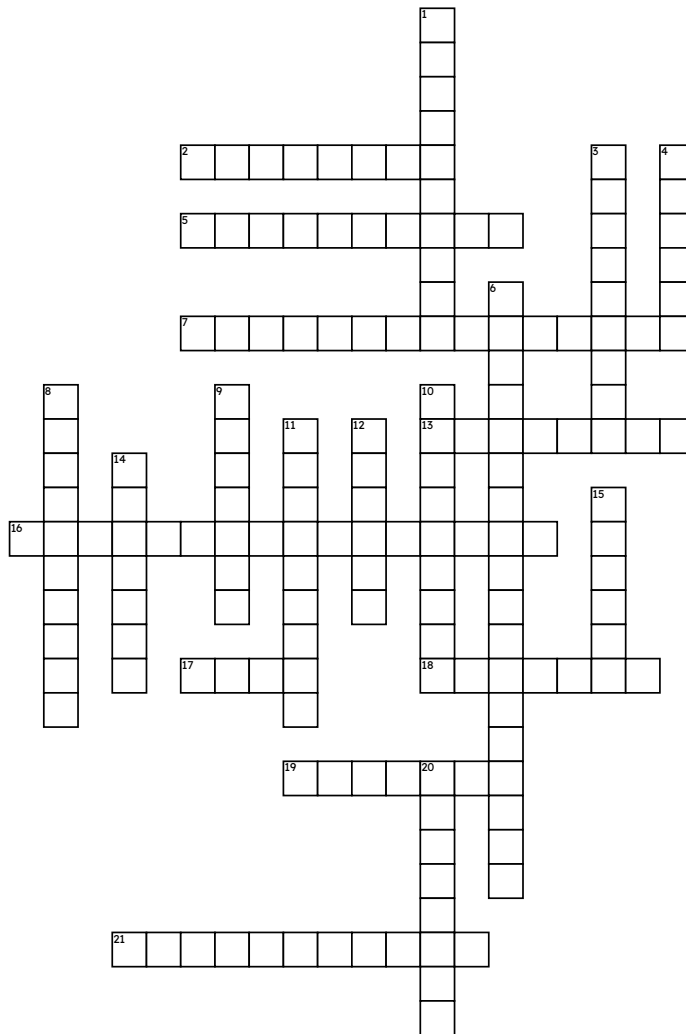


# Wedding Food and Beverages



## Across

**2.** This describes an event outside of human control or activity.

**5.** This is a very small fancy cake, biscuit, or sweet, typically made with marzipan and served after a meal.

**7.** A modern style of cooking that avoids rich, heavy foods and emphasises the freshness of the ingredients.

**13.** This refers to food that can be ordered as separate items, rather than part of a set meal.

**16.** This brings us the eclectic menus that can be found in pubs and clubs around the country; it includes dishes such as pasta, laksa, bangers and mash.

**17.** The most important meal of several ones in a particular situation.

**18.** The sweet course eaten at the end of a meal.

**19.** A bar, such as one at a large party, where drinks are sold by the glass.

**21.** The careful, appreciative tasting of various food, focusing on the gustatory system, the senses, high culinary art and good company.

**1.** A small savoury dish, typically served as an appetizer.

**3.** A small dish of food or a drink taken before a meal or the main course of a meal to stimulate one's appetite.

**4.** This is a type of hors d'œuvre held in the fingers and often eaten in one bite.

**6.** This is safe and healthy. It's produced without hazardous pesticides and chemicals, non-essential antibiotics or growth promotion supplements.

**8.** This is a cuisine based on one culture, but prepared using ingredients and flavors inherent to another culture.

**9.** A charge made by a restaurant or hotel for serving wine that has been brought in by a customer.

**10.** This is the dietary standard for Muslim people, as prescribed in the Qur'an (the Muslim scripture).

**11.** This generally refers to an inexpensive drinking wine served in restaurants.

**12.** The main course of a meal.

**14.** This is a strict gluten-free diet.

**15.** This is a term used to describe food that complies with the strict dietary standards of traditional Jewish law.

**20.** This is a type of food served in small bowls at an event.
