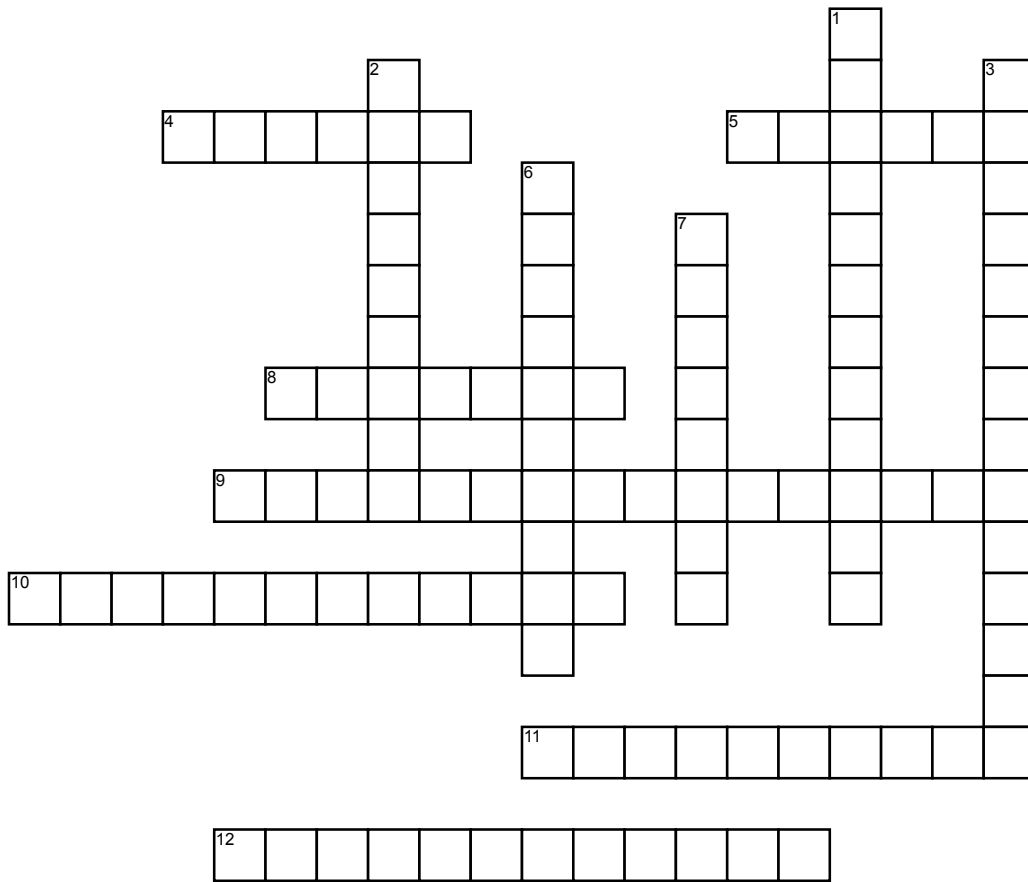


Wegener's Hypothesis
