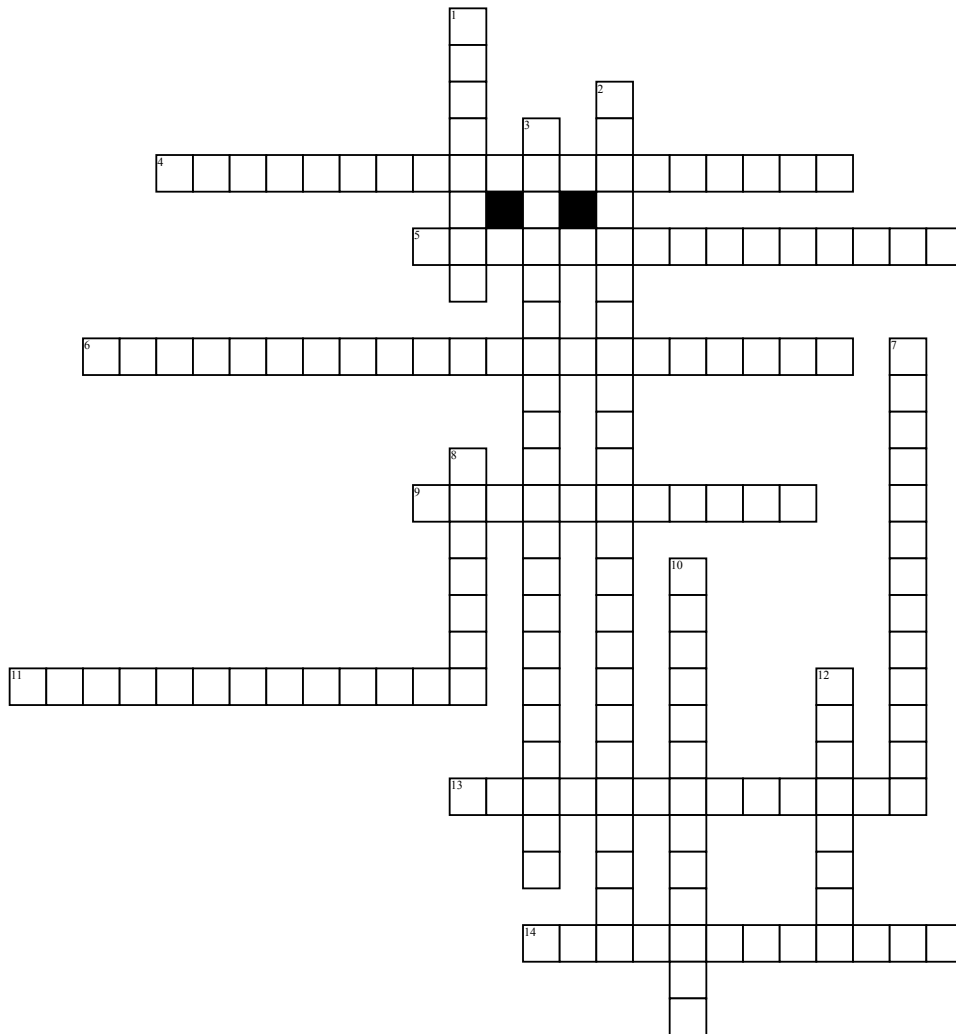


# Westward Expansion
