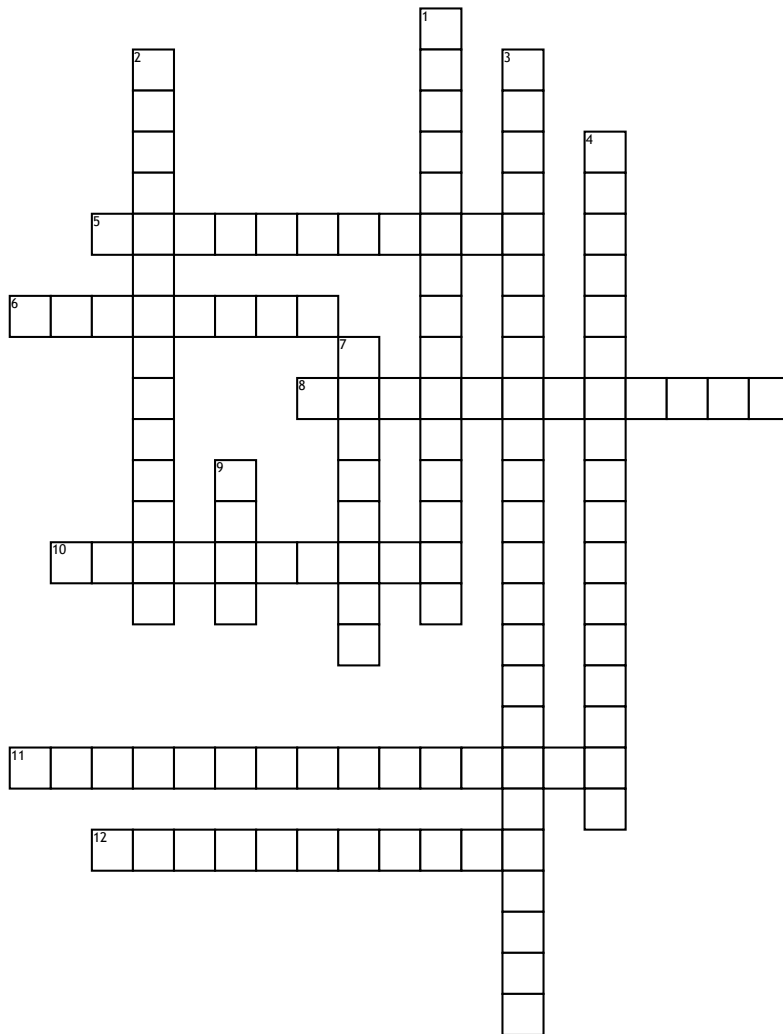


Westward expansion and American Culture
