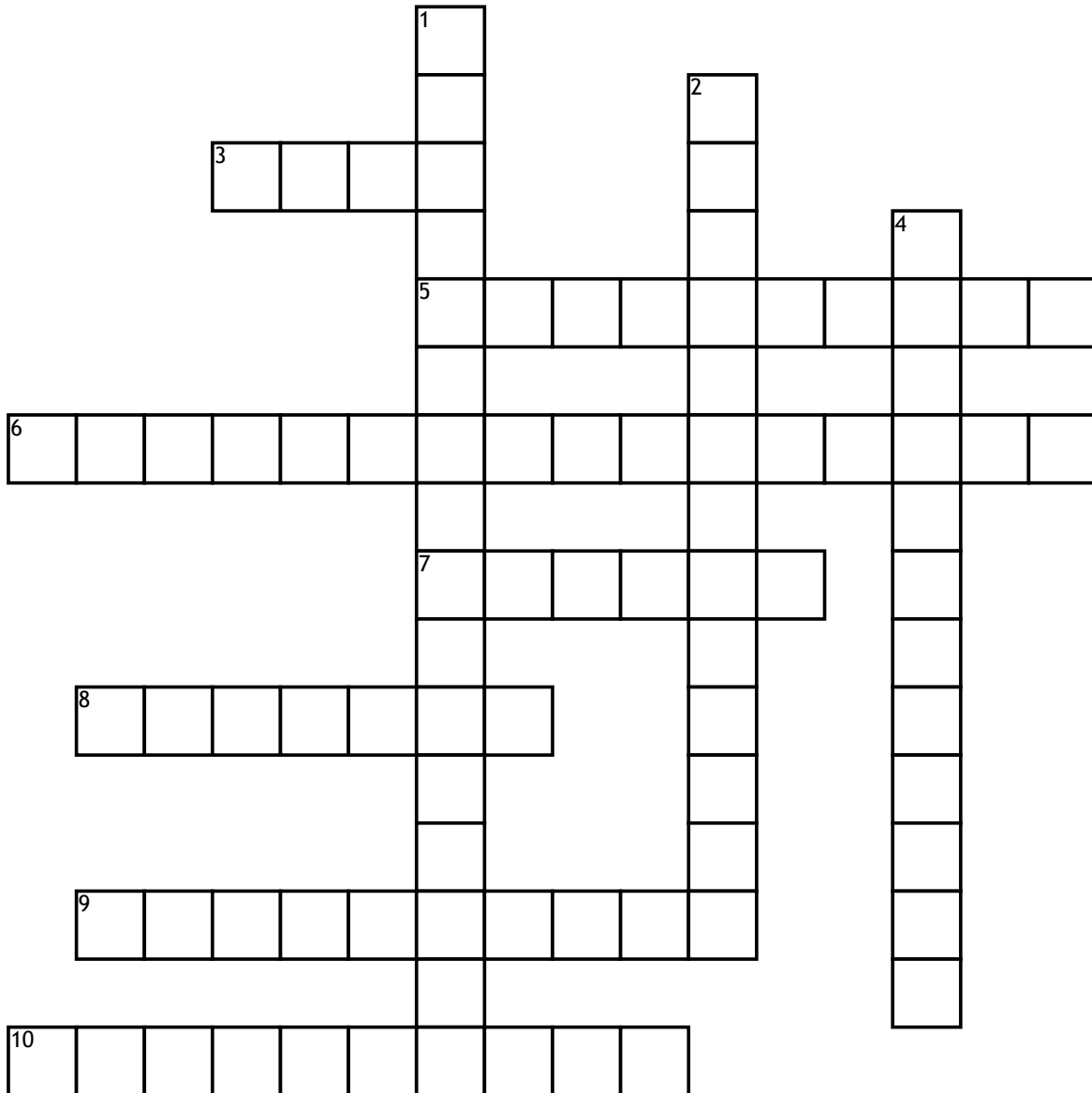


# What makes a good story?

- 2. Eases the tension. Shows how the main character resolves the conflict.
- 4. Shows how the conflict becomes more difficult. Builds suspense.
