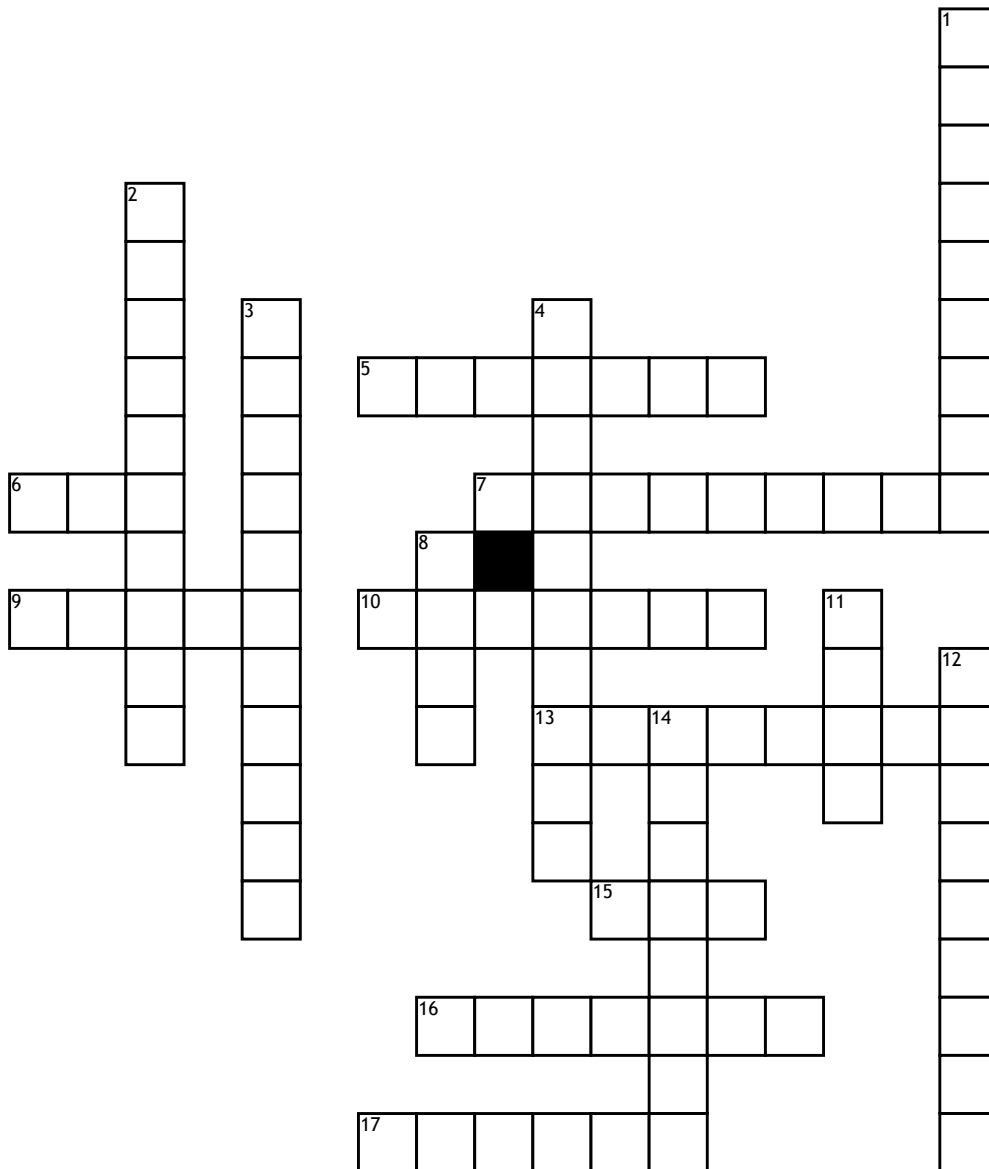

5. Clay dry enough to be fired
 6. A machine used for recycling dry clay
 7. Clay before it has been fired for the first time.
 9. Liquid that seals clay and makes it waterproof after firing
 10. Clay is called this after the first fire.
 13. Cutting rough edges off of the completed piece

15. A flat tool used to trim and shape or smooth clay at leather hard stage
 16. The act of removing air bubbles from clay
 17. Heating clay up to about 600 to 1000 degrees to bake it.

1. Clay becomes smaller as it dries
 2. A type of paint that can be used on clay before first fire

3. Stage of drying where clay can be trimmed but not dry enough to fire yet,
 4. A brown earth colored clay
 8. An extremely hot oven for firing clay
 11. Liquid clay used to mend cracks
 12. The technique whereby decorations are incised into a dark color underglaze.
 14. The act of carving patterns or letters into clay
