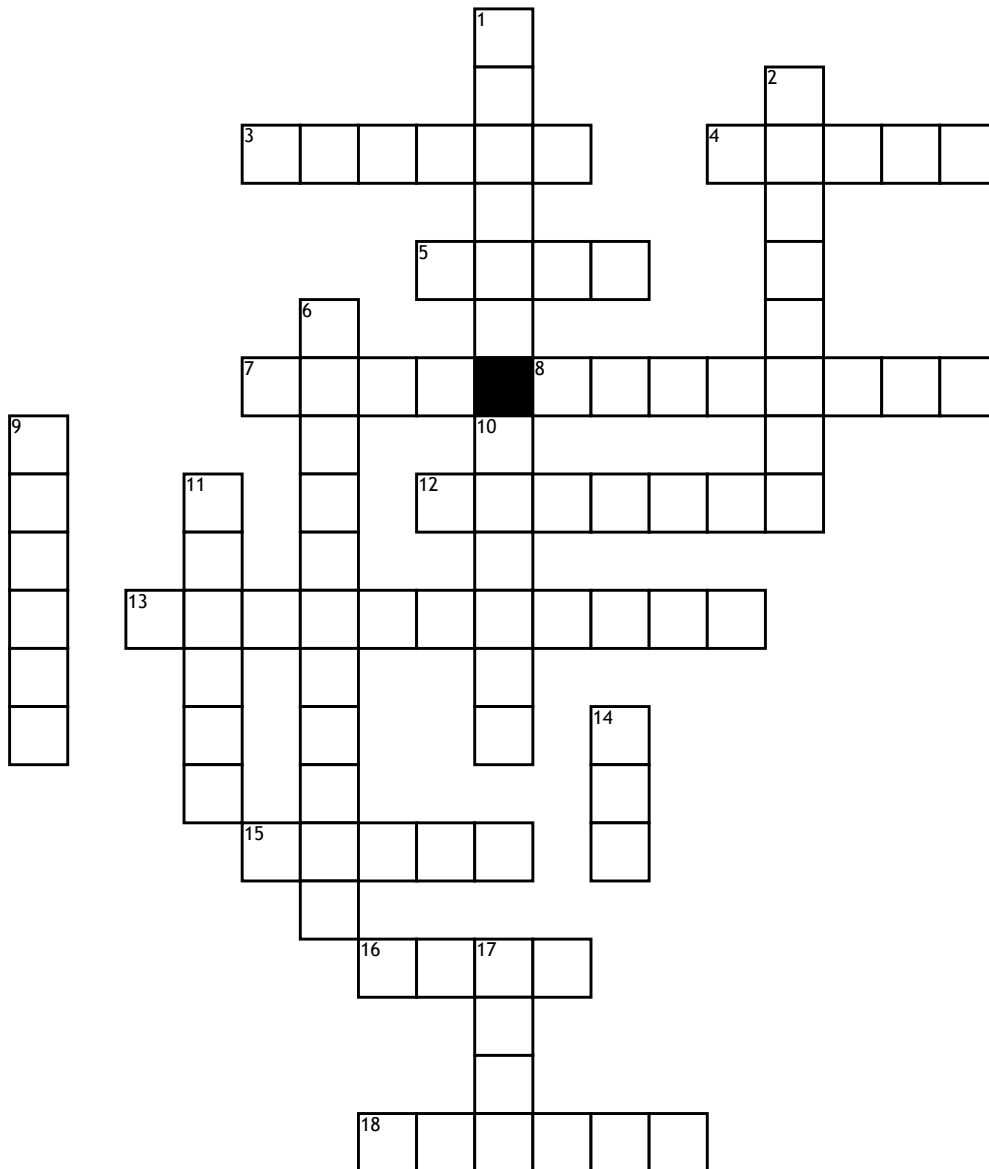


# What was the weapon?
