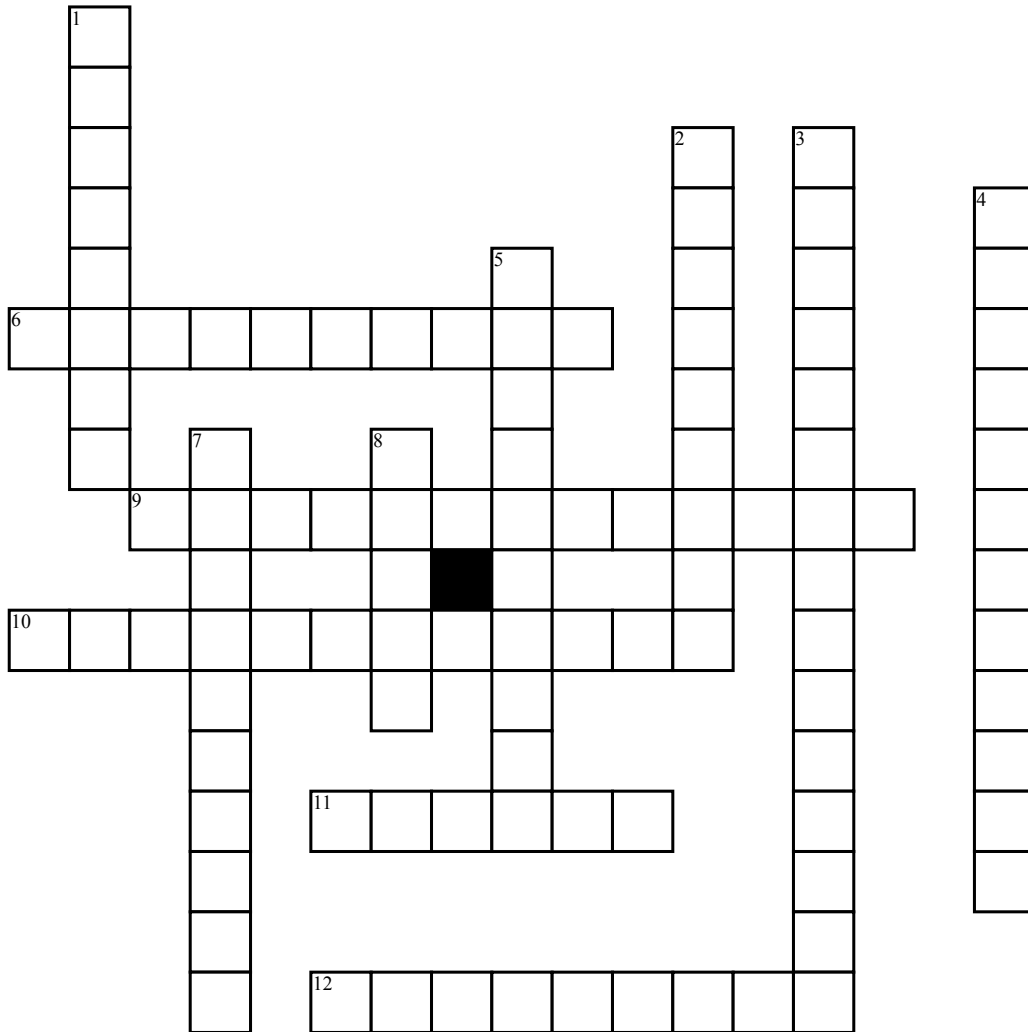


Whats In Your Blood
