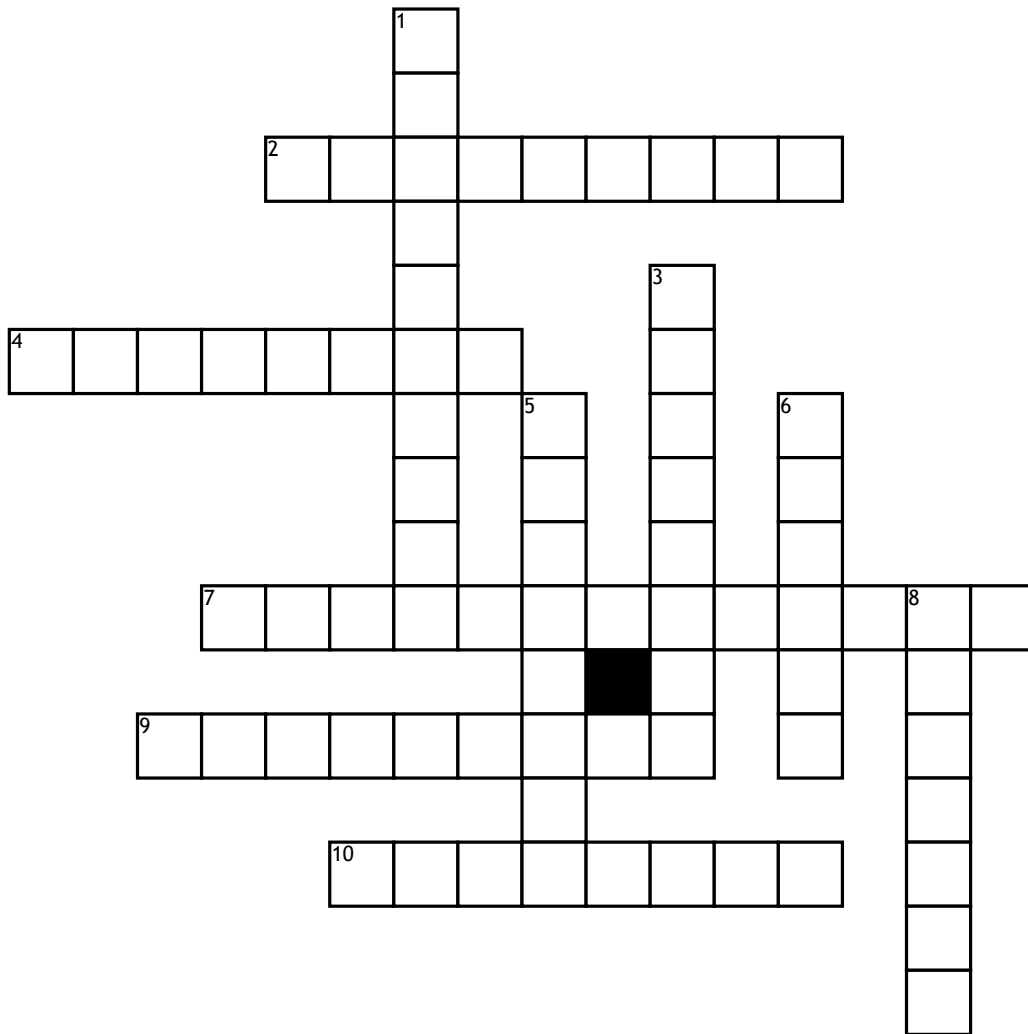


# What's in a name?
