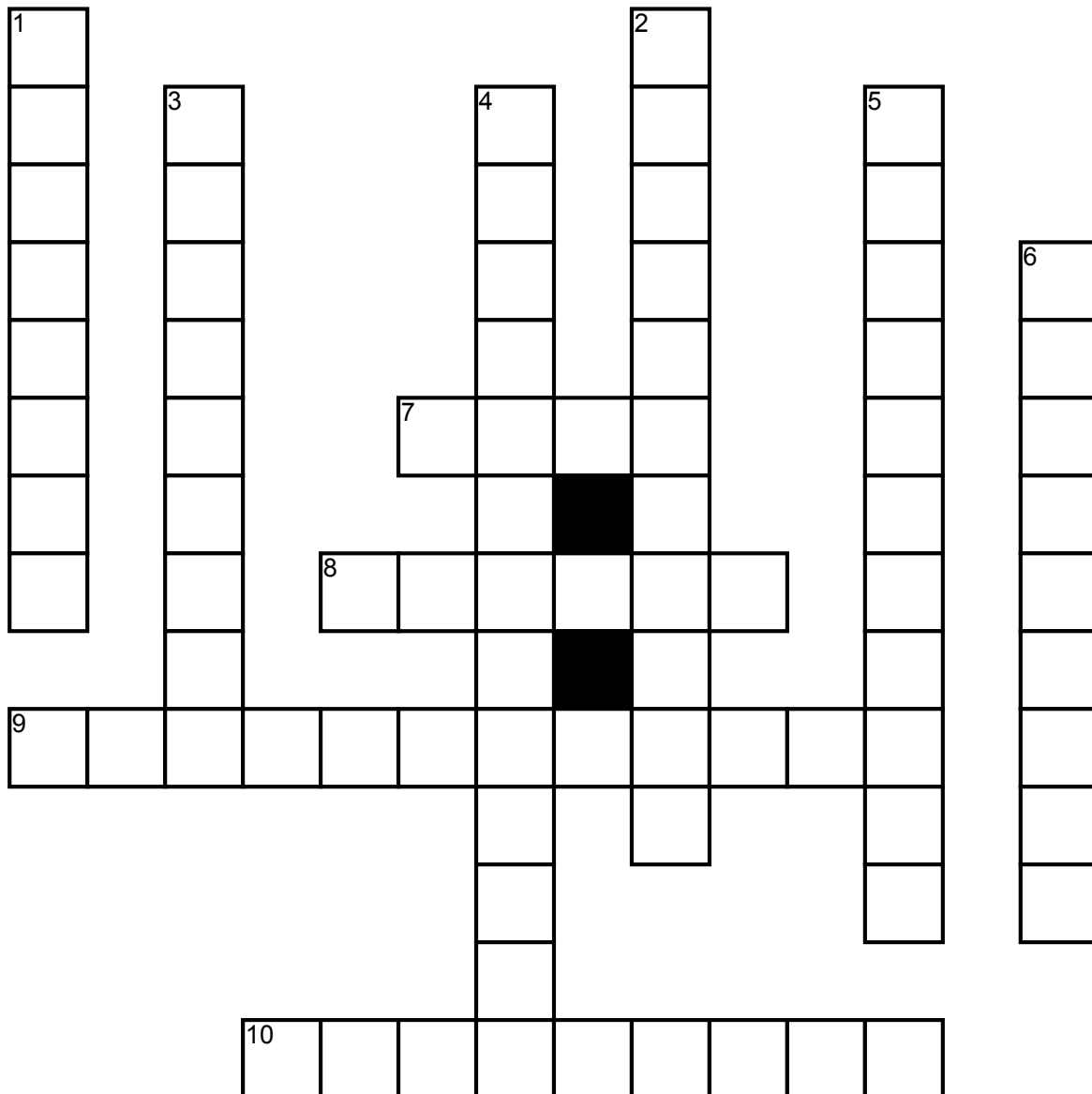

- 10.** Type of hearing to determine if a juvenile will be released

- 1.** Document describing an alleged offense and the reason for prosecution

- 2.** Type of commitment with a mandatory 10-40 year length of stay

- 3.** Must be completed before including documents in a case file or submitting court reports

- 4.** Necessary when determining whether there is enough information to support an alleged crime

- 5.** Less serious crime, like vandalism or shoplifting

- 6.** Type of court providing juvenile courts with shared authority to preside over human trafficking cases
