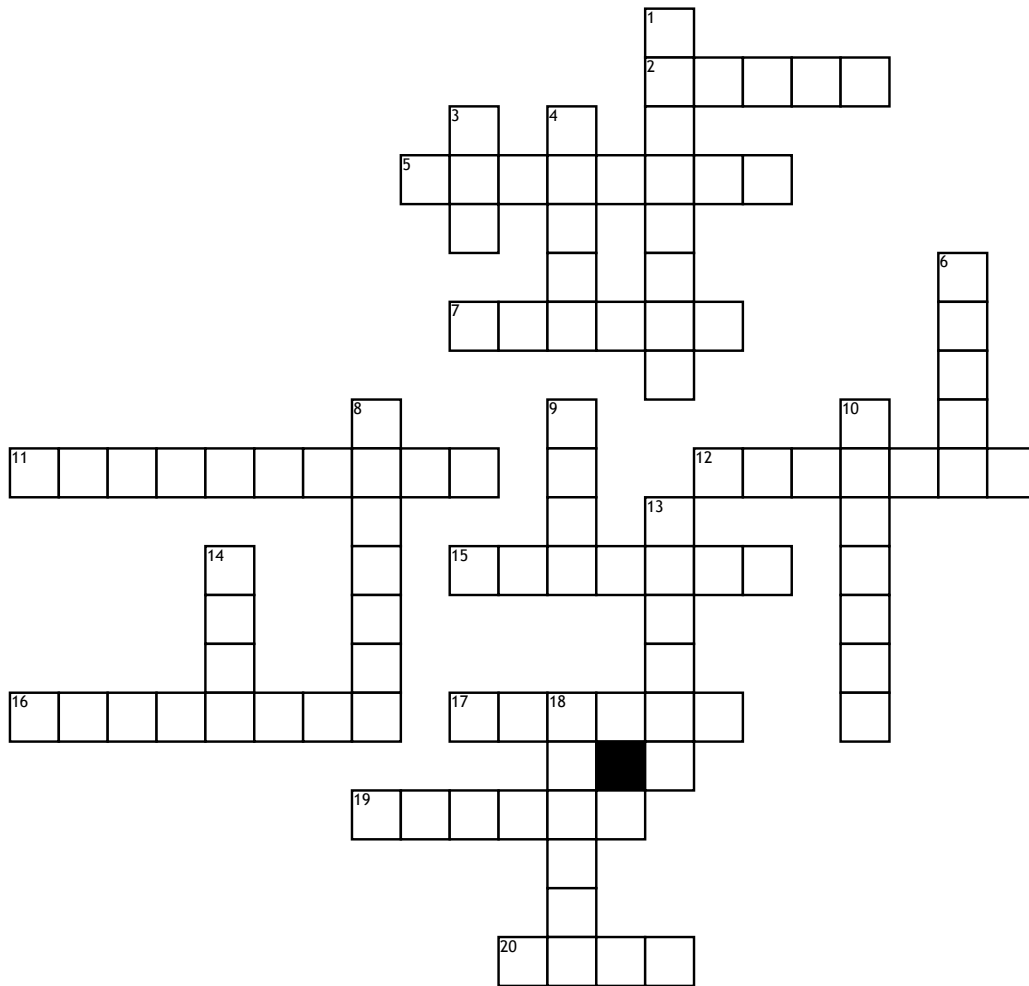


Where the Red Fern Grows
