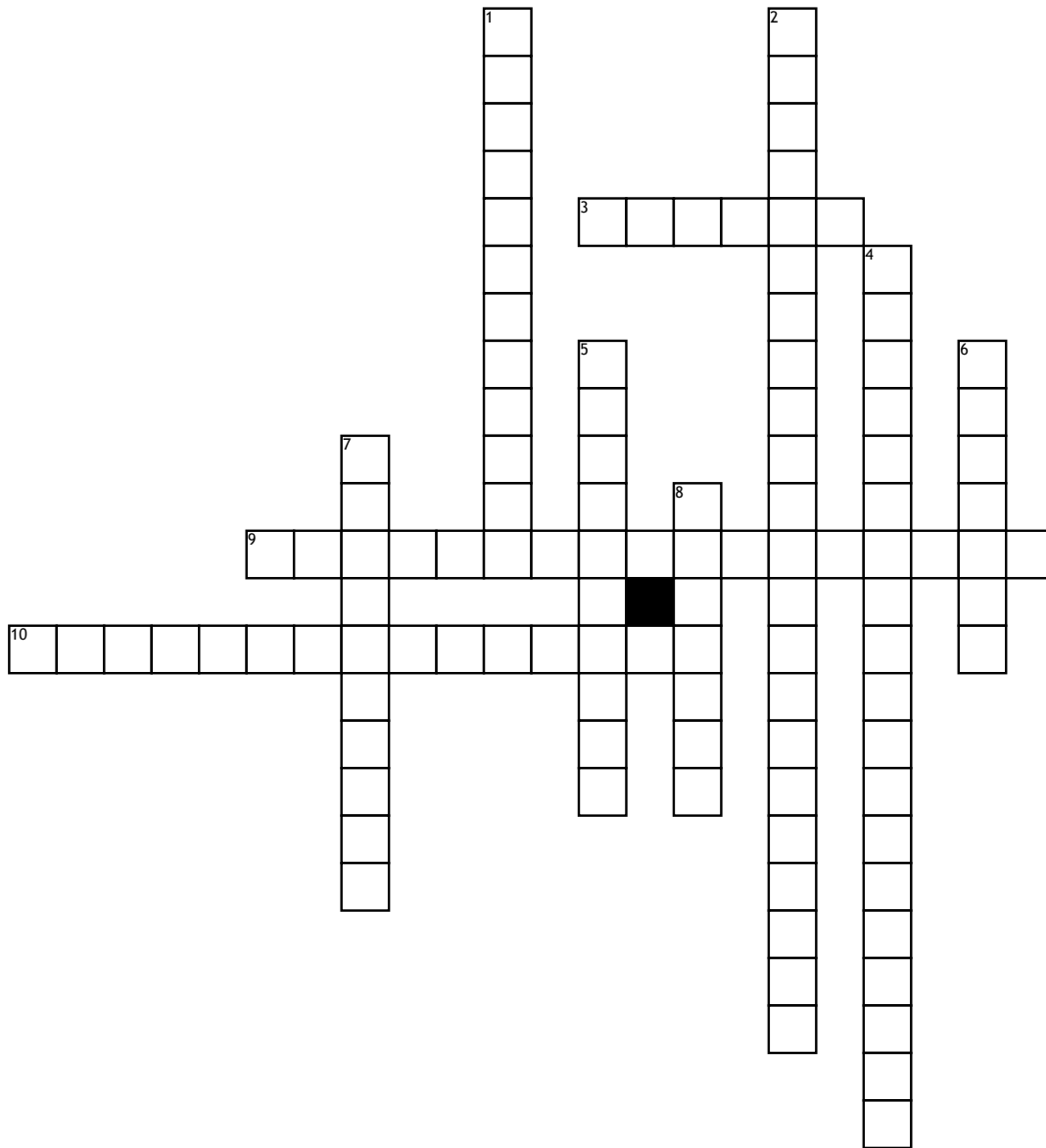


William Shakespeare Plays
