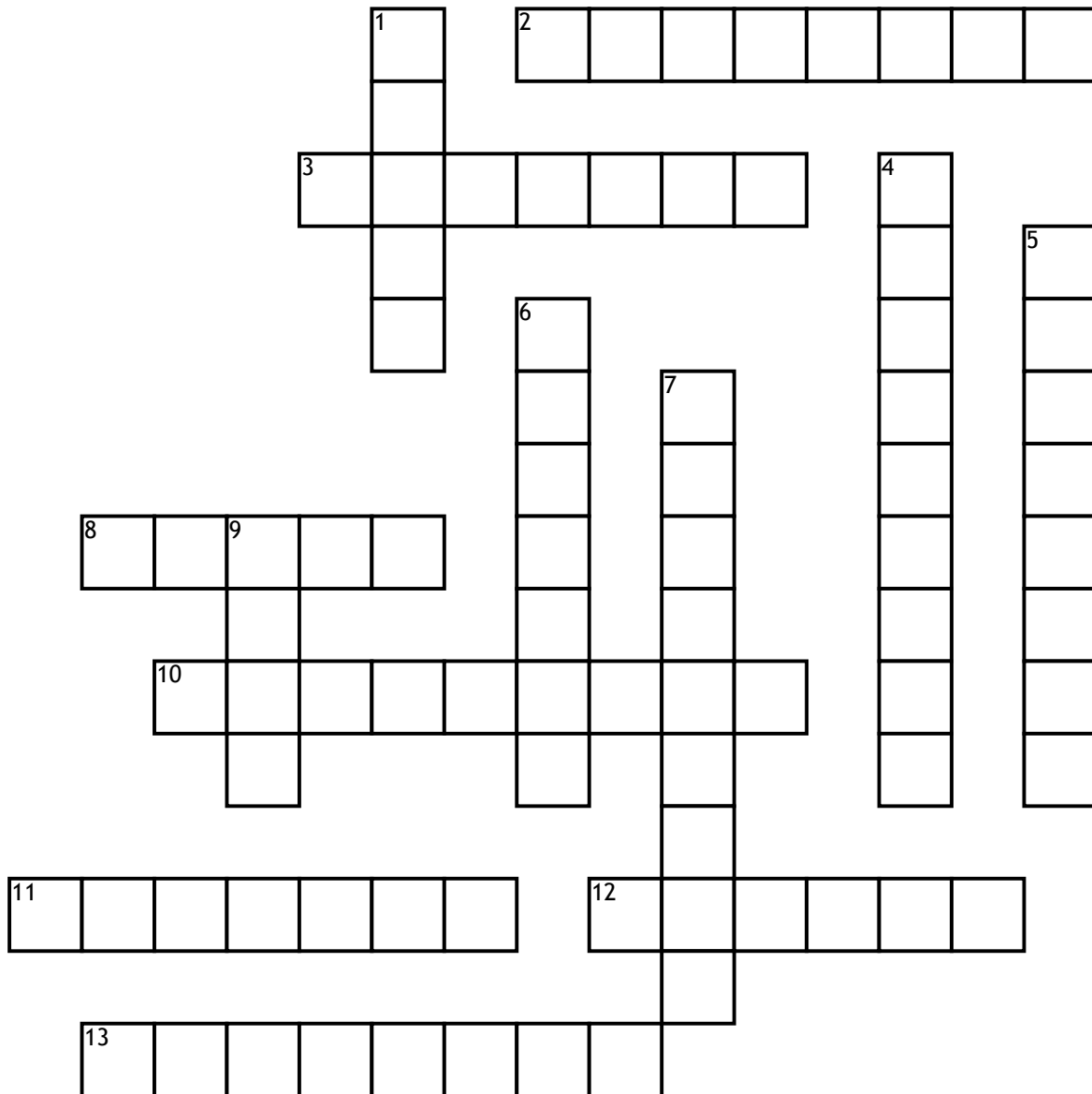


Word Master Crossword Puzzles
