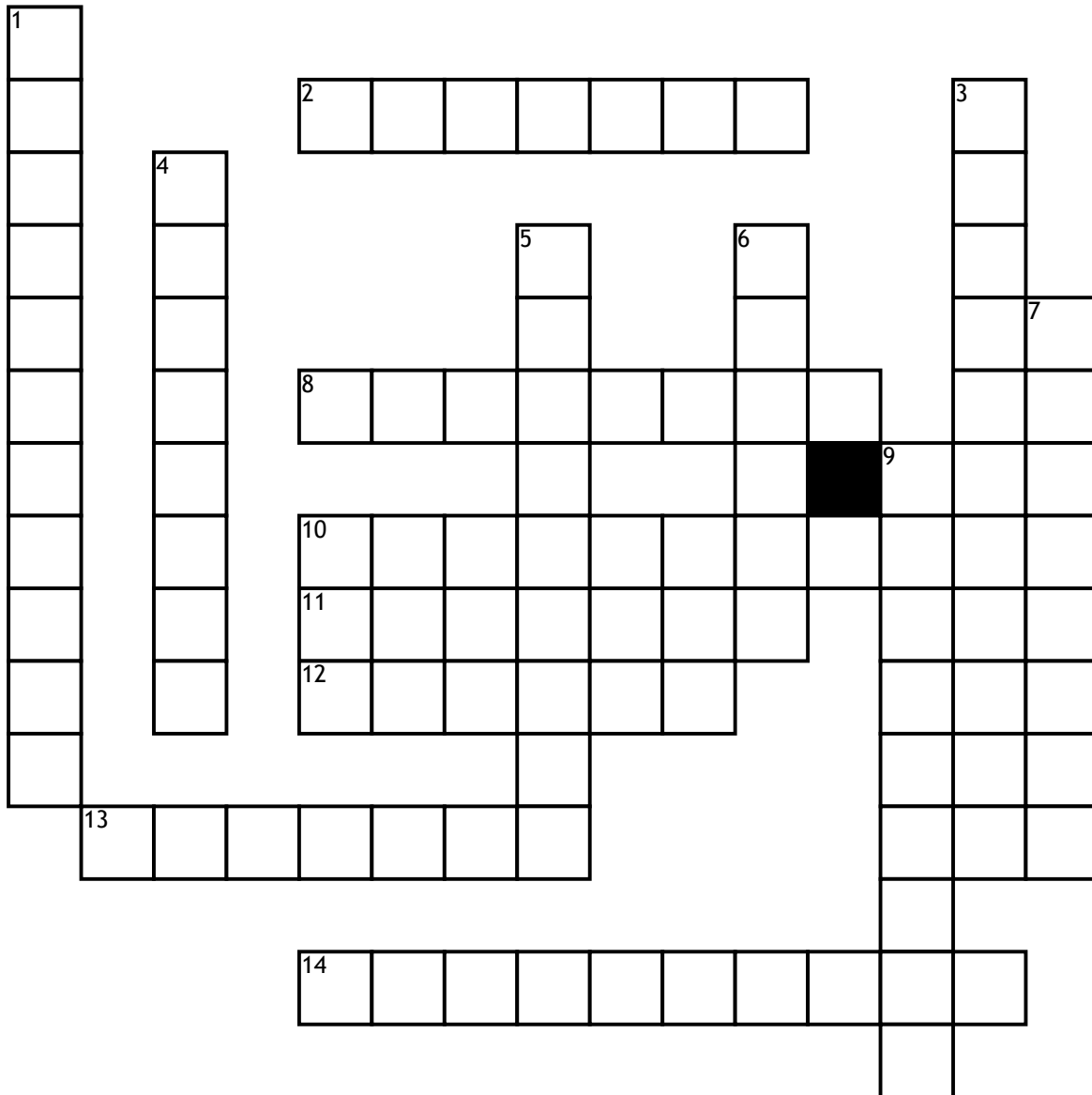


# Word Puzzle
