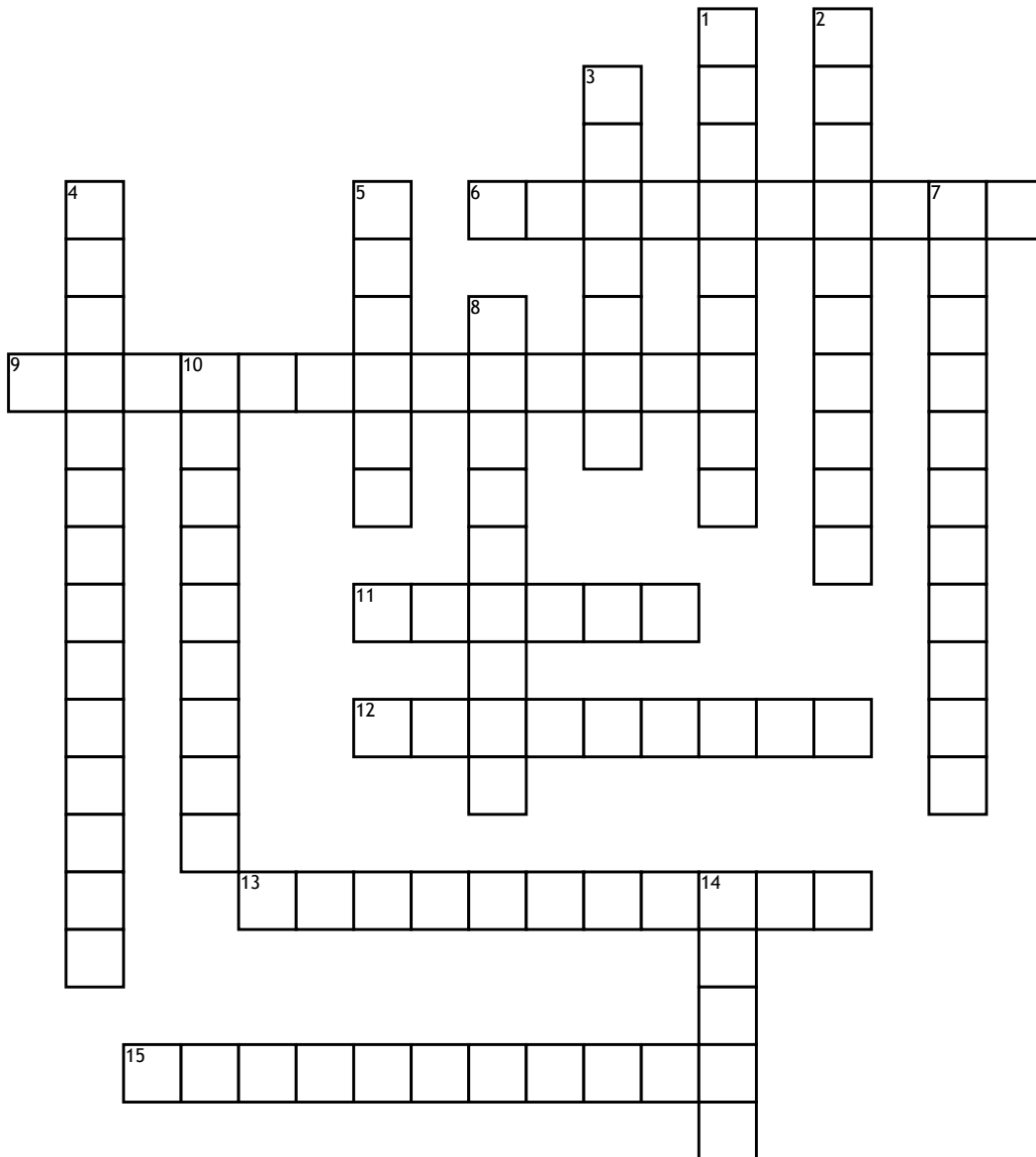


Word Wizard Crossword
