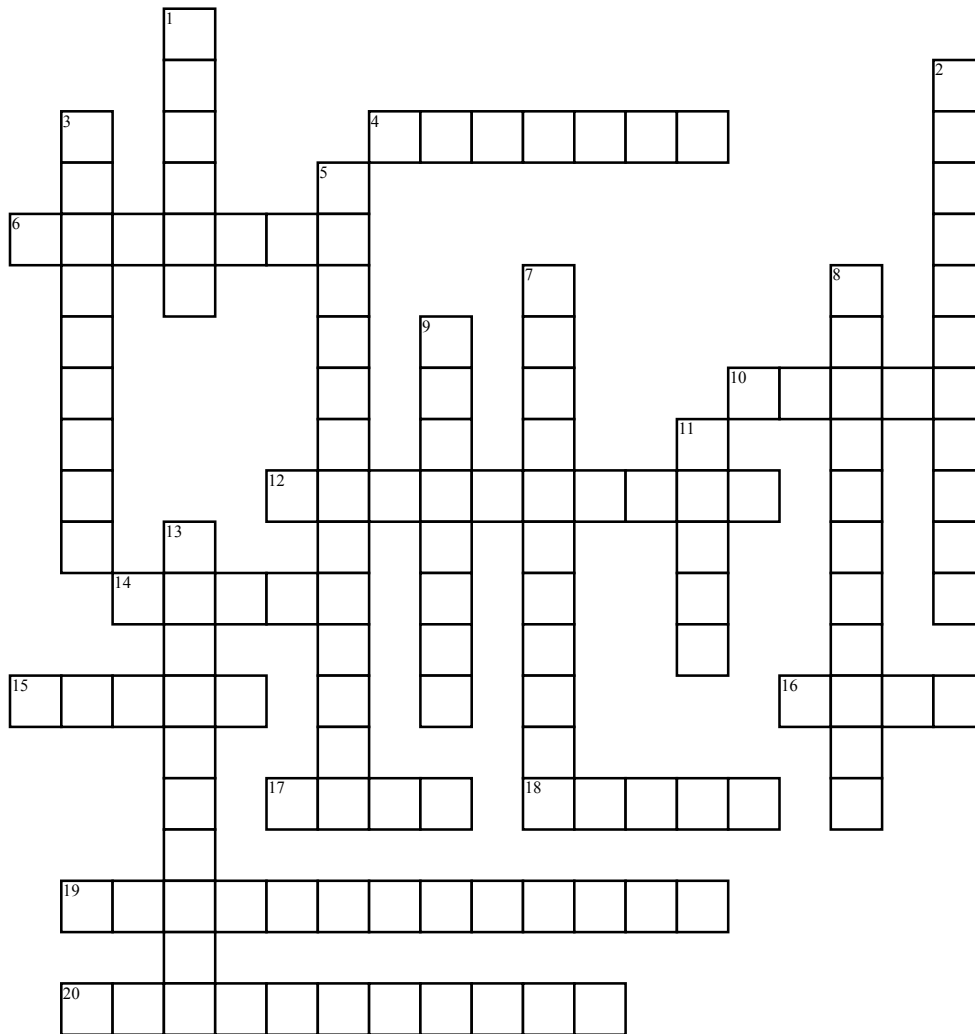


# Wordcross in Respiratory and Circulatory



## Across

4. a passage of airway in the respiratory tract that conducts air into the lung  
 6. the air sacs at the end of the respiratory tree of the lung  
 10. the main artery in the human body, originating from the left ventricle of the heart  
 12. One of the heart's chambers that receives oxygenated blood from the lungs  
 14. Pumps the blood throughout the body  
 15. carries the materials throughout the body  
 16. the body's primary organ of smell and also functions as part of the body's respiratory system

17. A tube used to transport blood vessels throughout the body  
 18. the tube that carries food from the throat to the stomach  
 19. chamber within the heart that pumps deoxygenated blood to the lungs  
 20. The act of breathing includes: inhaling and exhaling air in the body

## Down

1. a chemical element with symbol O  
 2. an extremely small blood vessel located within the body tissues  
 3. Movement of the blood from the heart, to the lungs, and back to the heart

5. chamber within the heart that pumps deoxygenated blood to the lungs  
 7. One of the heart's chambers that receives deoxygenated blood from the body  
 8. This network supplies tissues in the body with oxygen and other nutrients, transports hormones, and removes unnecessary waste products.  
 9. Movement of blood from the heart to the rest of the body, excluding the lungs  
 11. Part of the body supplying blood with oxygen  
 13. the tube that carries food from the throat to the stomach
