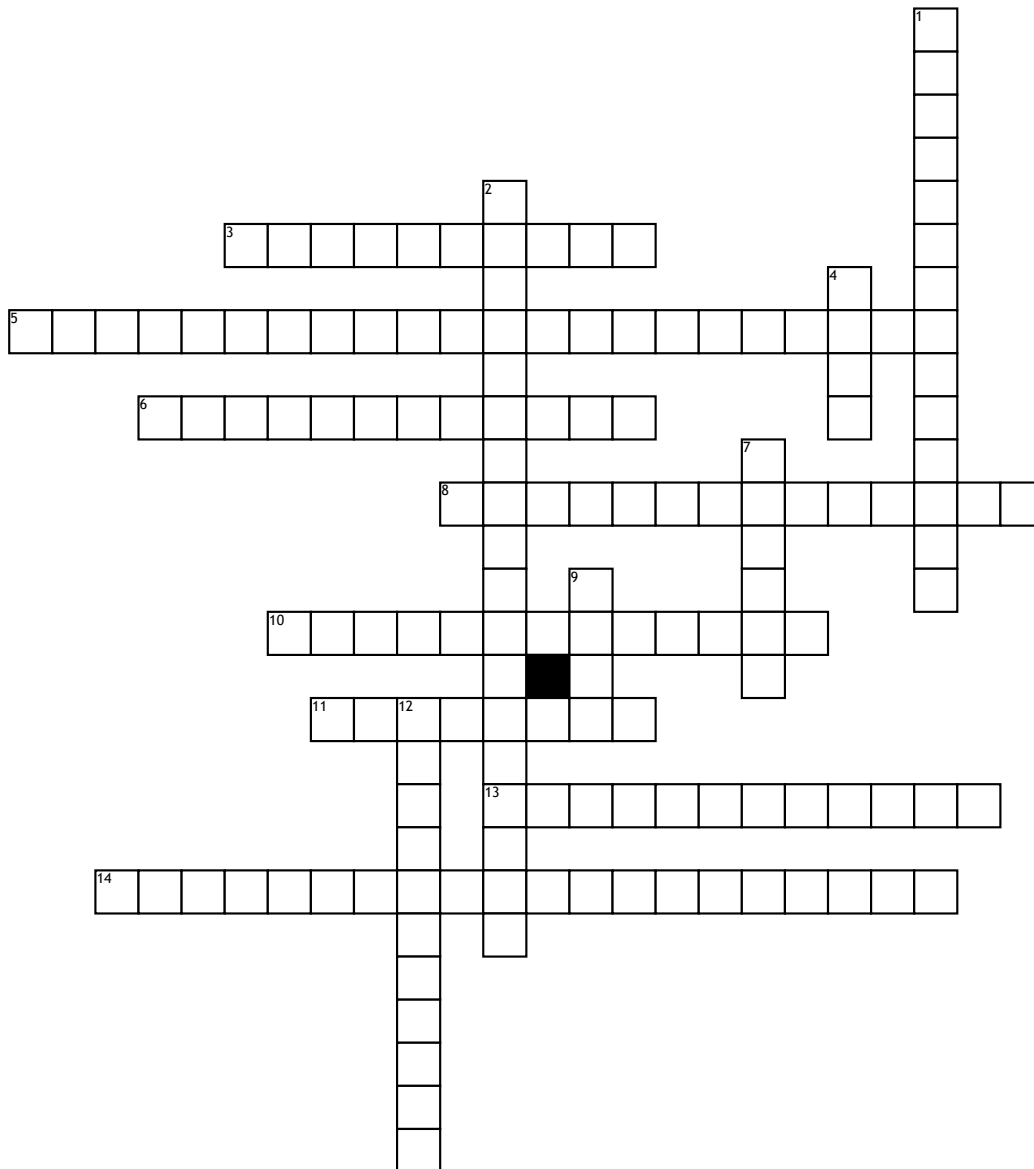


# Work Compensation

- 3. money taken from your pay resulting in the actual amount you receive
- 5. IRS
- 6. paid for the services rendered or the job you do
- 8. Soc. Sec.
- 10. holiday pay, if you regularly make \$10 hour, but get paid \$20 per hour

- 11. monthly pay before deductions
- 13. If the regular pay is \$10 hour and you work beyond the 40 hours for \$15 per hour
- 14. wages paid only for the hours actually worked
