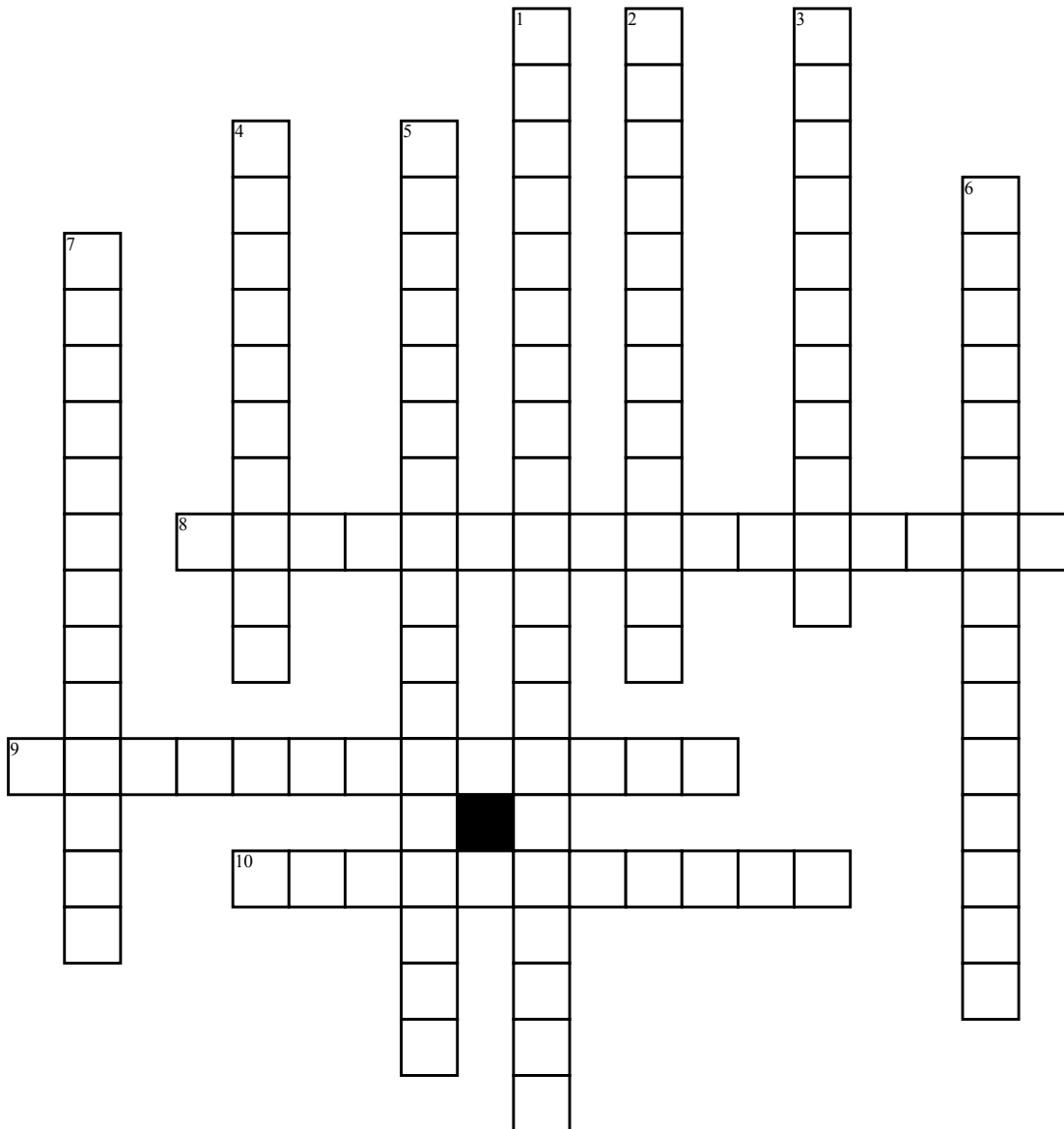


World Heritage Sites in SA
