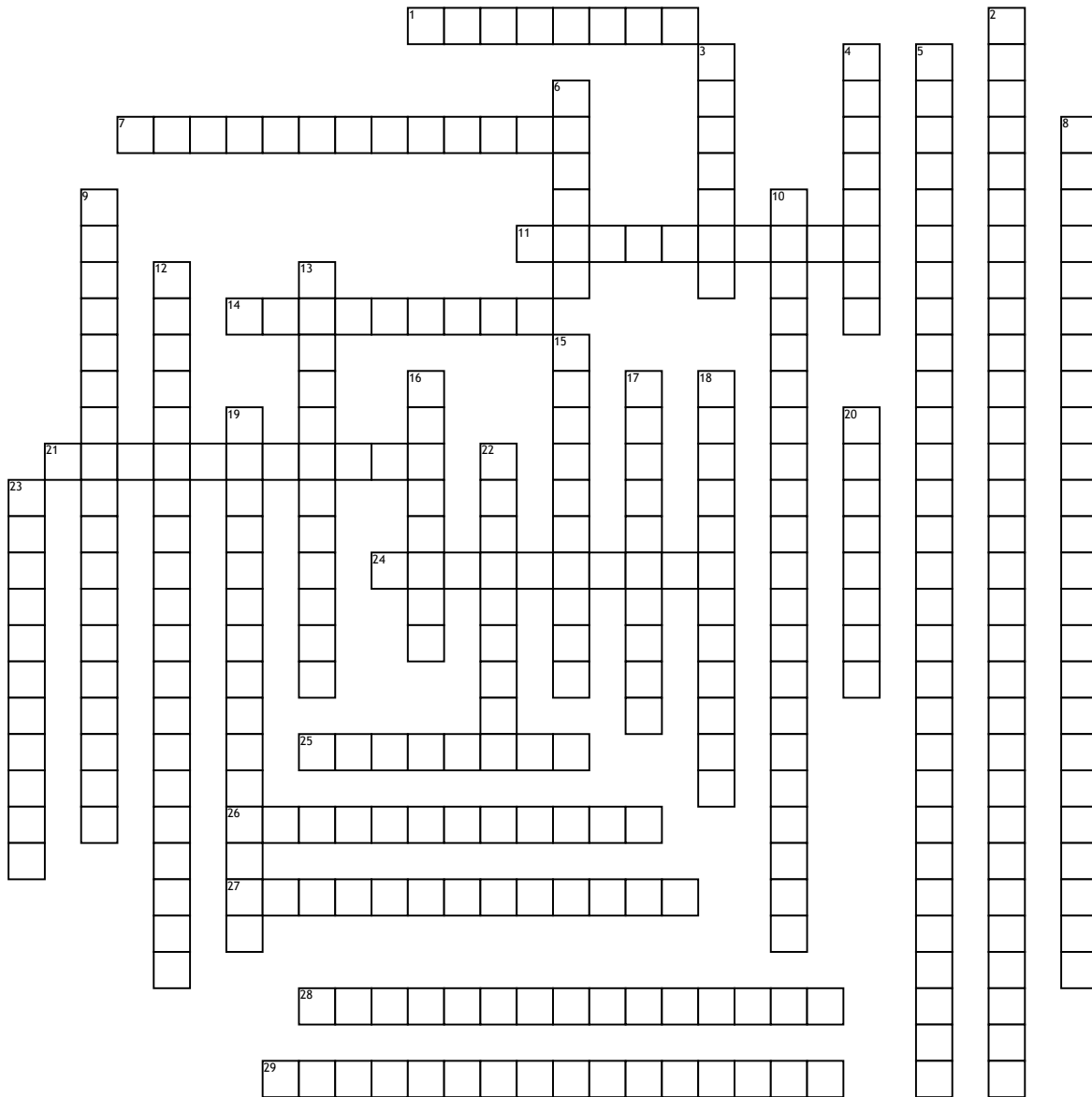

- 1. a federal subject of Russia. It is located in the North Caucasus, situated in the southernmost part of Eastern Europe, and within 100 kilometres of the Caspian Sea
- 7. a formal and organized choice by vote of a person for a political office or other position
- 11. a retired Polish politician and labour activist. He co-founded and headed Solidarity
- 14. A south african policy of complete separation of the races, including the banning of all social contacts between blacks and whites
- 21. A restructuring of the soviet economy to permit more local decision making
- 24. A polish labor union that during the 1980' became the main force of opposition to communist rule in poland
- 25. Is an autonomous territory on the eastern side of the Pearl River estuary in South China
- 26. an economic program implemented in Russia by Boris Yeltsin
- 27. a South African anti-apartheid revolutionary, political leader, and philanthropist, who served as President of South Africa from 1994 to 1999.
- 28. A huge space in Beijing, China; in 1989, the site of a student uprising in support of democratic reforms
- 29. a Russian and former Soviet politician. He was the eighth and last leader of the Soviet Union

- 2. An organization founded in 1964 with the purpose of the "liberation of Palestine" through armed struggle, with much of its violence aimed at Israeli civilians
- 3. Conservative Islamic group that took control of Afghanistan after the Soviet union withdrew its troops
- 4. Palestine campaign of civil disobedience against Israeli occupation of the west bank and Gaza Strip
- 5. a Mexican political party founded in 1929 that held power uninterruptedly in the country for 71 years from 1929 to 2000
- 6. a country in the Middle East, on the southeastern shore of the Mediterranean Sea and the northern shore of the Red Sea
- 8. A system of governing in which the ruler's power is limited by law
- 9. A set of goals adopted by the Chinese leader Deng Xiaoping in the late 20th century
- 10. Included Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, kyrgystan, and Tajikistan
- 12. an open process in which the rights of the community to be informed, to provide comments to the Government and to receive a response from the Government are met through a full opportunity to be involved and to express needs and goals
- 13. The principle that the greater number should exercise greater power

- 15. was a country in Southeastern and Central Europe for most of the 20th century
- 16. A soviet policy of openness to the free flow of ideas and information
- 17. Holy warriors who banded together to fight the Soviet-supported government
- 18. a Soviet and Russian politician and the first President of the Russian Federation, serving from 1991 to 1999
- 19. A policy of murder and other acts of brutality by which Serbs hoped to eliminate Bosnia's muslim population after the break up of yugoslavia

- 22. the ruling committee of the Communist party in the Soviet Union
- 23. is a Mexican businessman and politician who served as the 55th President of Mexico from December 1, 2000 to November 30, 2006
