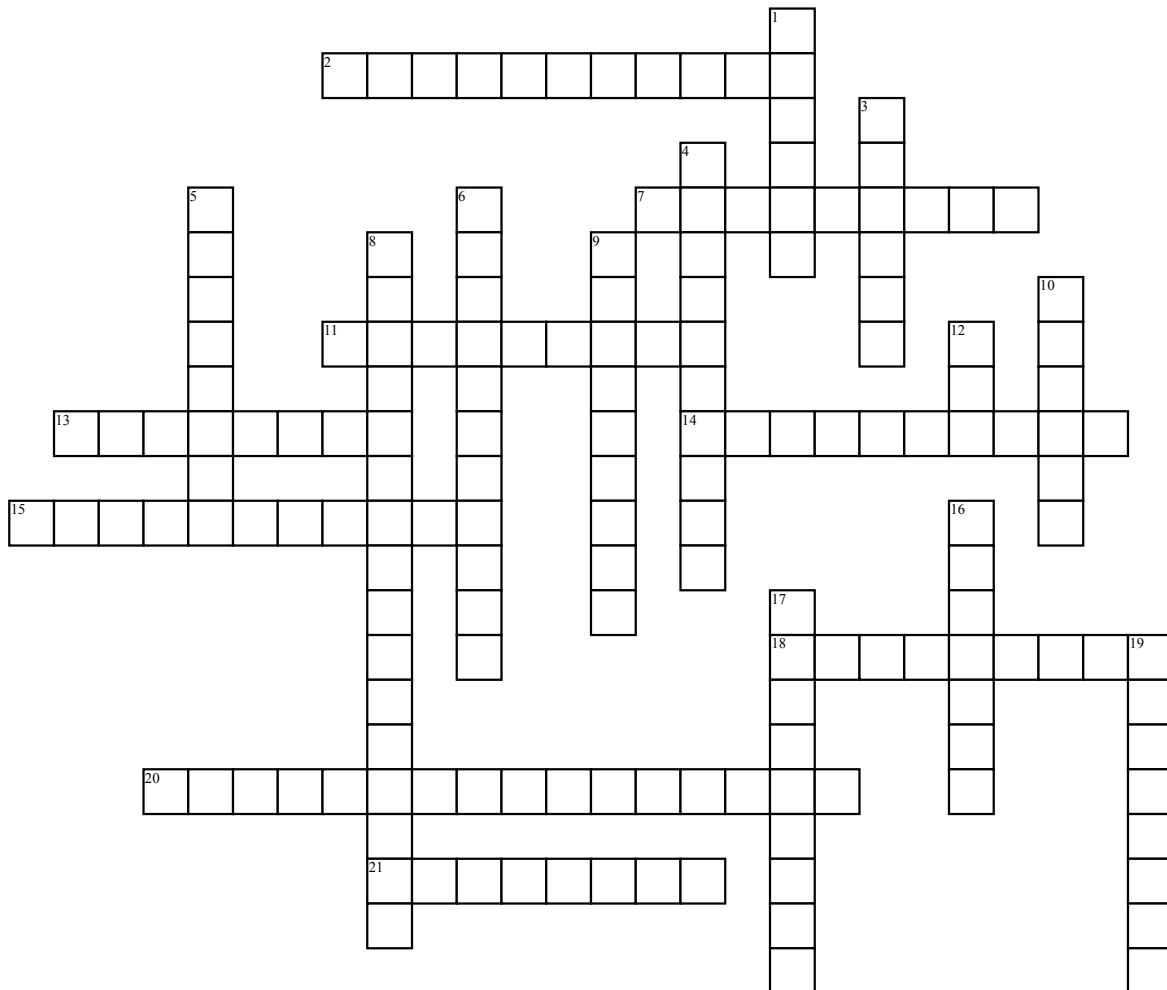


World War II Book: Bomb
