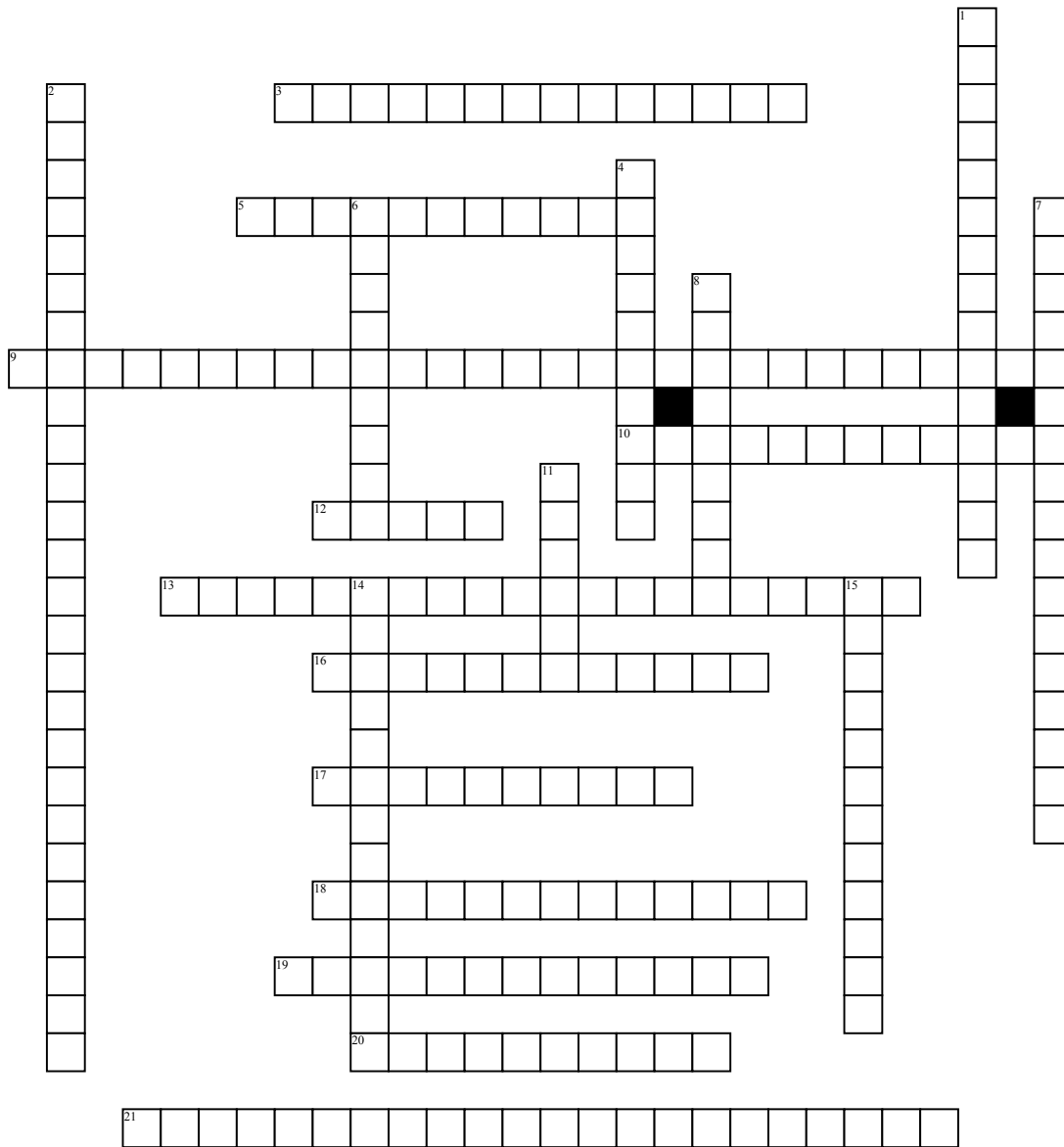

- 9. immediate cause for US entry into WWI
- 10. Foreign policy the US adopted after WWI
- 12. broke the stalemate caused by trench warfare
- 13. Court case that limited freedom of speech
- 16. Entered the War in 1917

- 17. New weapon that caused massive casualties
- 18. President who tried to keep the US out of WWI
- 19. Stretched over 400 miles; led to a stalemate
- 20. Germans called them U-Boats
- 21. His assassination was the immediate cause of WWI

- 2. Name of the U.S. soldiers that fought in WWI

- 6. Ship was sunk by a German U-Boat killing 128 Americans (one reason for US entry into WWI)
- 7. Proposed an alliance between Germany and Mexico (one reason for US entry into WWI)
- 8. First used by Germany in 1917
- 11. Great Britain, France and Russia
- 14. Germany, Austria-Hungary
- 15. Threatened freedom of speech; punished dissenters during wartime
