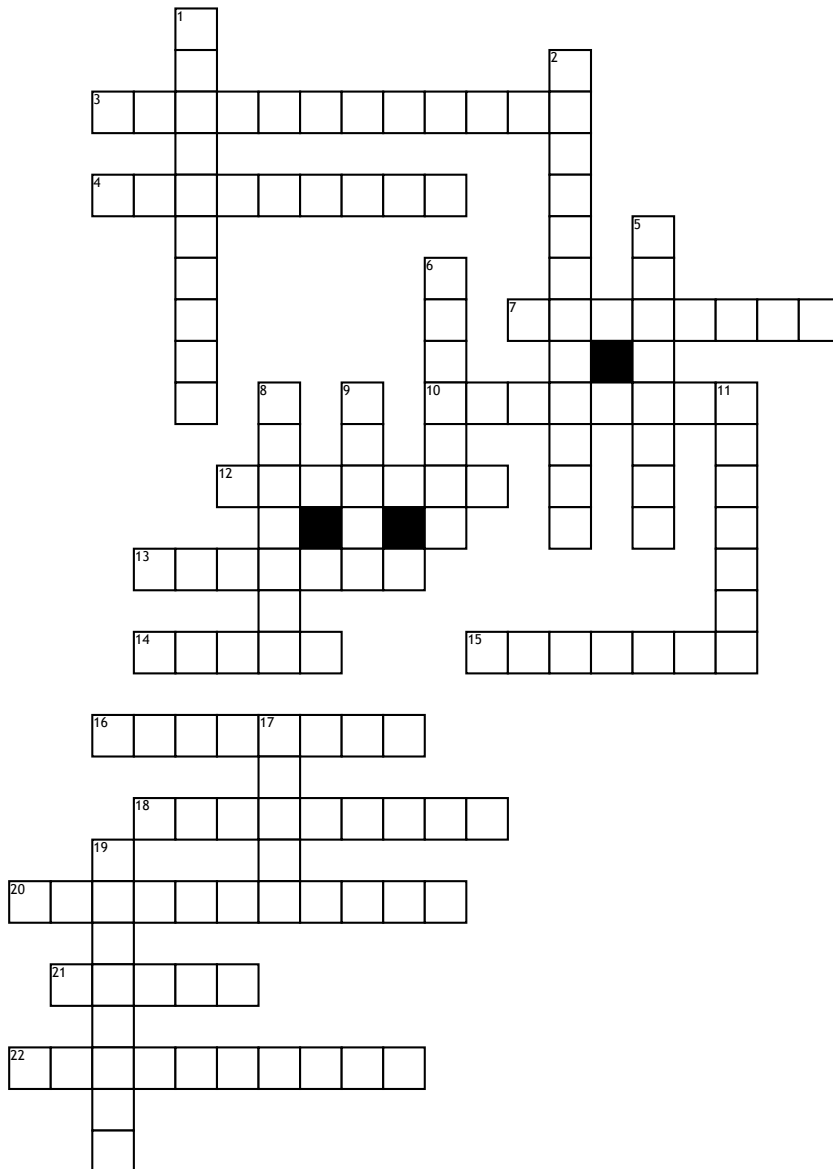


# Wound Dressings



## Across

- 3.** A non-breathable dressing that adheres to the skin. In contact with wound exudate, the polysaccharides and other polymers absorb water and swell, forming a gel. The gel may be designed to drain, or to remain within the structure of the adhesive matrix.
- 4.** A waterproof transparent film dressing used to secure wound dressings.
- 7.** A two stretch tubular retention bandage (otherwise known as yellow line)
- 10.** A sterile dark brown ointment used to remove exuding wounds, reduce bacteria and slough from the wound bed.
- 12.** A light and breathable bandage.
- 13.** An aliginate dressing impregnated with 100% manuka honey. Effective against a broad range of bacteria.
- 14.** A thin, acrylic adhesive dressing that allows you to see the wound. It is designed for the ease of application.

- 15.** Not to be used unless under the instruction of the tissue viability team. Absorbs and binds free wound exudations, which could delay wound healing and damage the wound environment.
- 16.** A two layer compression bandage system with controlled pressure
- 18.** A pad indicated for sloughy wounds (leg ulcers, pressure ulcers, diabetic, acute or chronic wounds)
- 20.** A wound dressing used on severely exuding wounds. The absorbent core binds and traps exudate.
- 21.** A non woven sterile swab.
- 22.** A retention used to hold a primary wound dressing in place, providing extra protection during the healing process.

## Down

- 1.** A total barrier film applicator
- 2.** Used to protect a fragile wound.

- 5.** A transparent dressing used for low exudation.
- 6.** A non-woven retention tape.
- 8.** A non-adherent surgical dressing containing the disinfectant povidone-iodine.
- 9.** A cohesive inelastic compression bandage (should only be used under strict or vascular specialist supervision)
- 11.** This is a foam dressing is used in wounds with low-to-high exudates levels. It can be used for a wide variety of wounds such as pressure ulcers, venous leg ulcers and non-infected diabetic foot ulcers.
- 17.** This is a soft-absorbent sub compression bandage. It is also available as a longer size for longer legs. Properties: Absorbs exudate. Redistributes pressure to help prevent damage to bony prominences. Helps to shape the leg. Soft and comfortable.
- 19.** A non-medicated impregnated dressing for atraumatic wound treatment.
