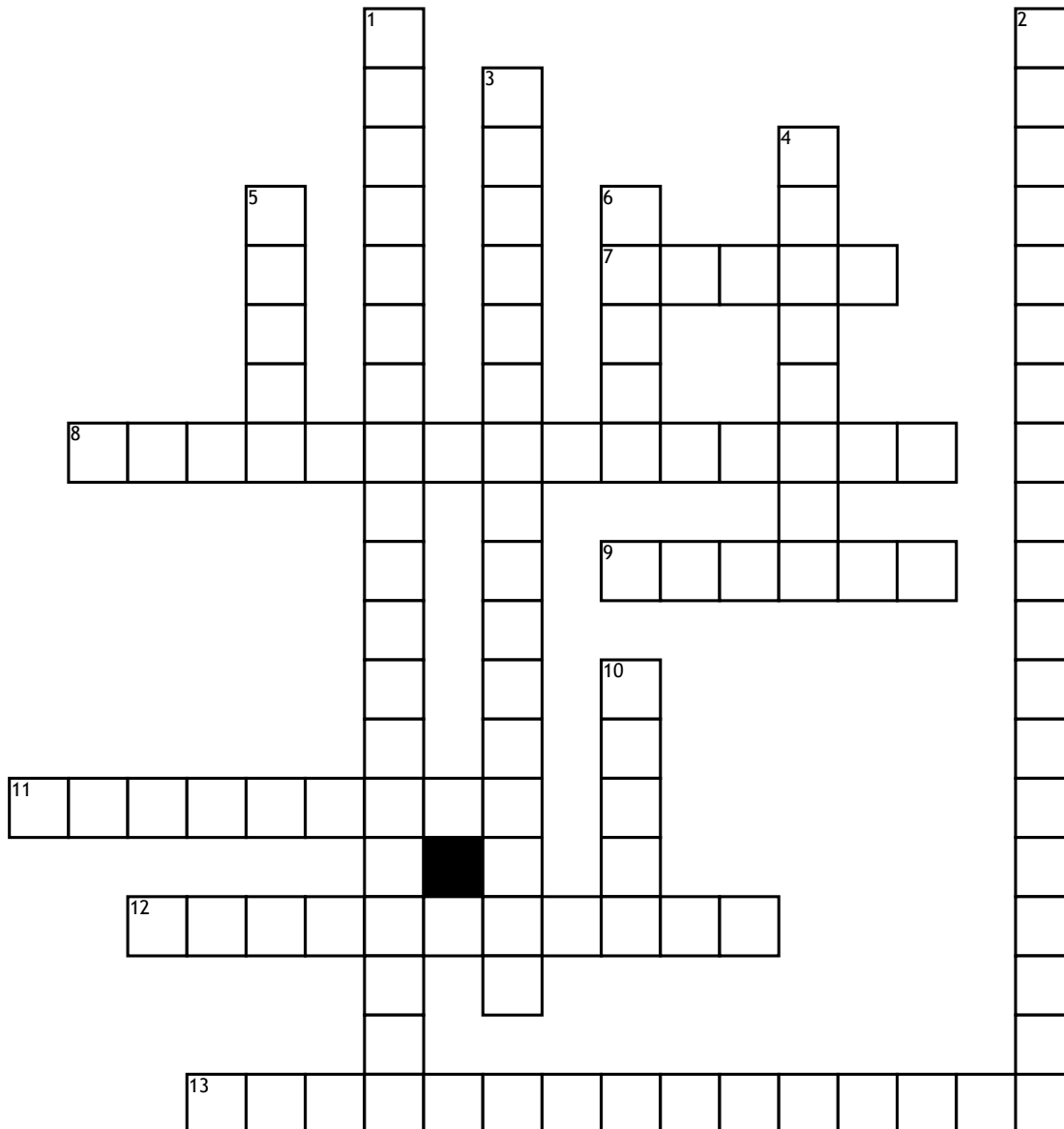

**7.** It is part of the Earth's surface that is identified and given meaning by people. The life of every person and animal is influenced by this.

**11.** A living community of plants and animals within an environment. They can be large or microscopic.
