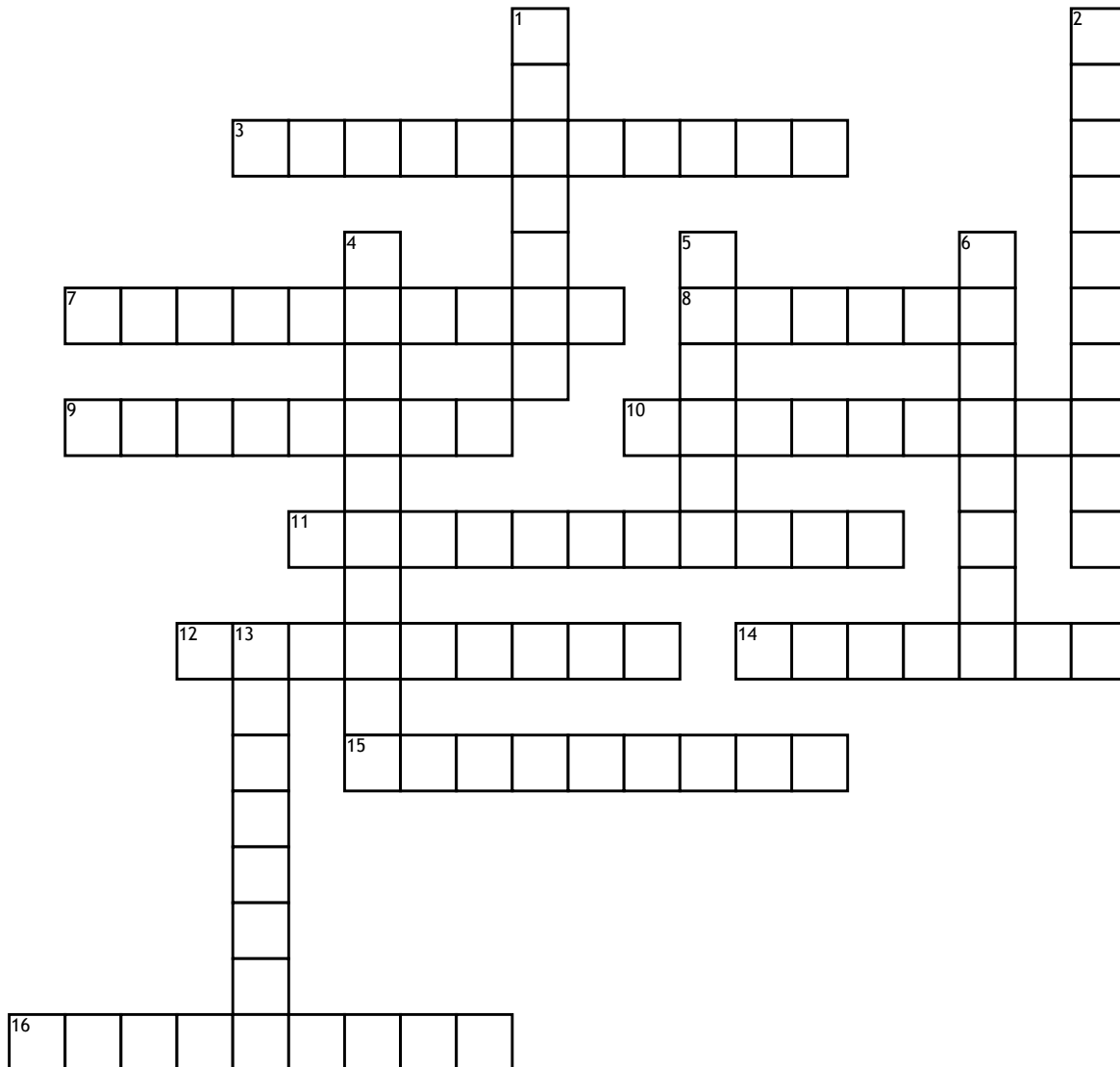

 7. meaningless repetition or imitation of the movements of others as a symptom of psychiatric disorder.
 8. the transparent layer forming the front of the eye.
 9. capacity for sensation and feeling :sensibility.
 10. a graphic record produced by audiometry.
 11. a surgical procedure in which a tiny incision is created in the eardrum (tympanic membrane) to relieve pressure caused by excessive buildup of fluid, or to drain pus from the middle ear.

 14. the spiral cavity of the inner ear containing the organ of Corti, which produces nerve impulses in response to sound vibrations.
 15. the vision in one of the eyes is reduced because the eye and the brain are not working together properly.
 16. the material of which the chromosomes of organisms other than bacteria (i.e., eukaryotes) are composed. It consists of protein, RNA, and DNA.
