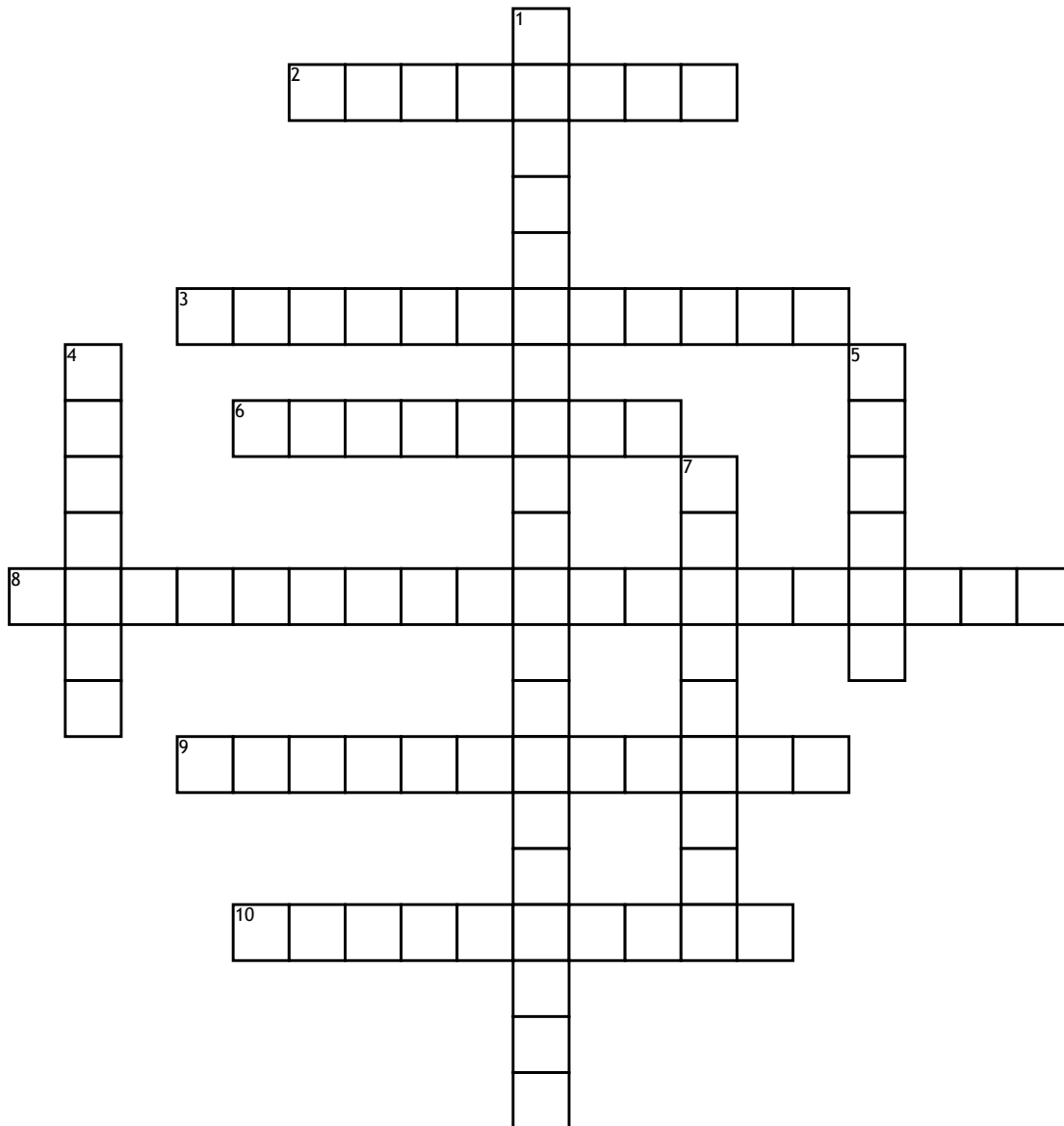


# Information Classifications



## Across

2. identifiable information is data that can be traced back to an individual and that, if disclosed, could result in harm to that person
3. information has significant Value for companies, and unauthorised disclosure or dissemination could result in severe financial or reputational damage
6. information includes anything that poses a risk to the company in question
8. The removal of information that could lead to an individual being identified
9. This refers to information that is already a matter of public record or knowledge

10. information surrounding to a government body and is restricted according to level of sensitivity

## Down

1. Information is fully anonymised if there are at least 3-5 individuals to whom the information could refer to
4. Information is subject to controls on access, such as only allowing valid logons from a small group of staff
5. information can be disclosed or disseminated without any restrictions on content, audience or time of publication.
7. Information is data that must be protected from unauthorised access to safeguard the privacy or security
