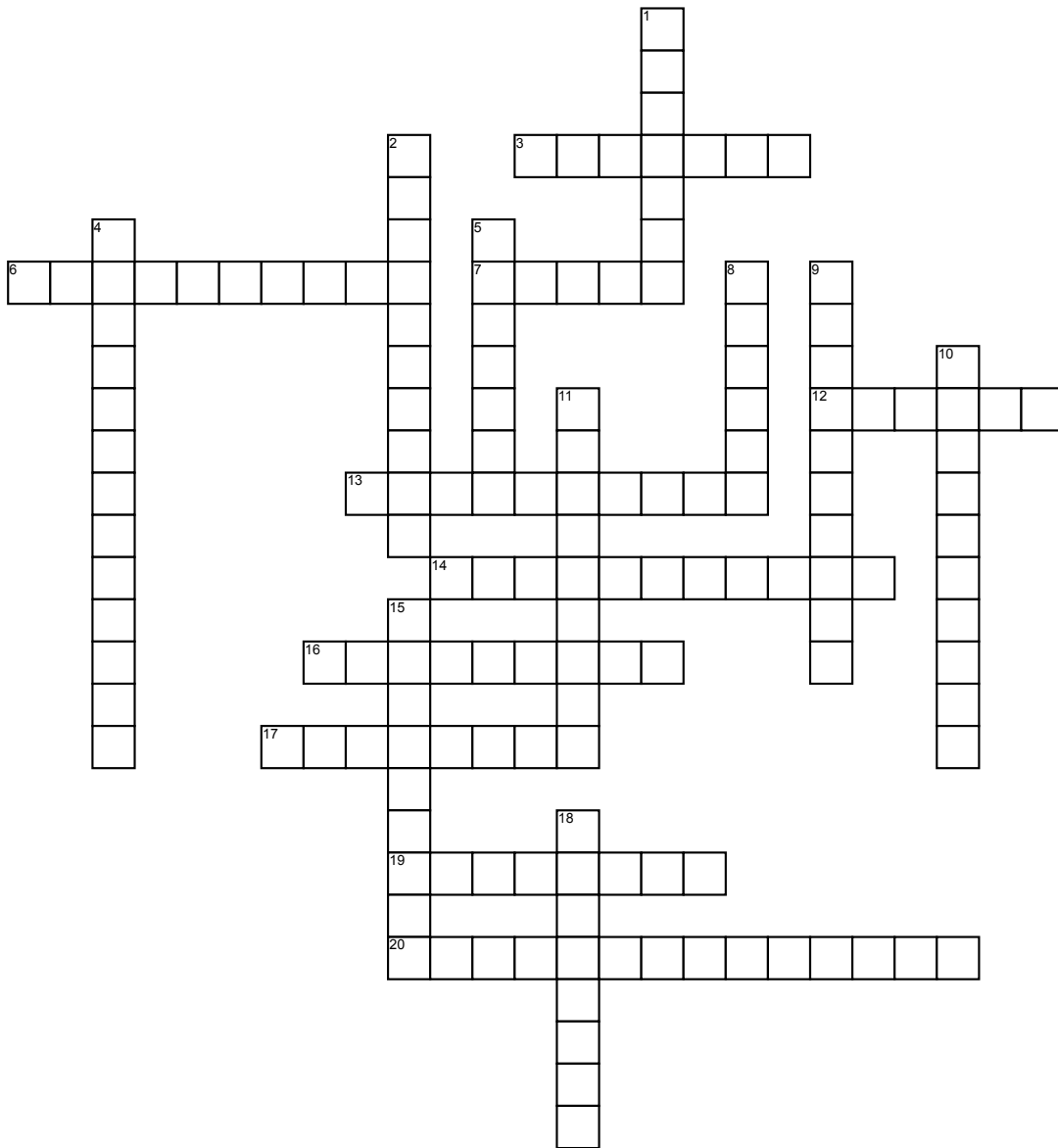


Skeletal Crossword
