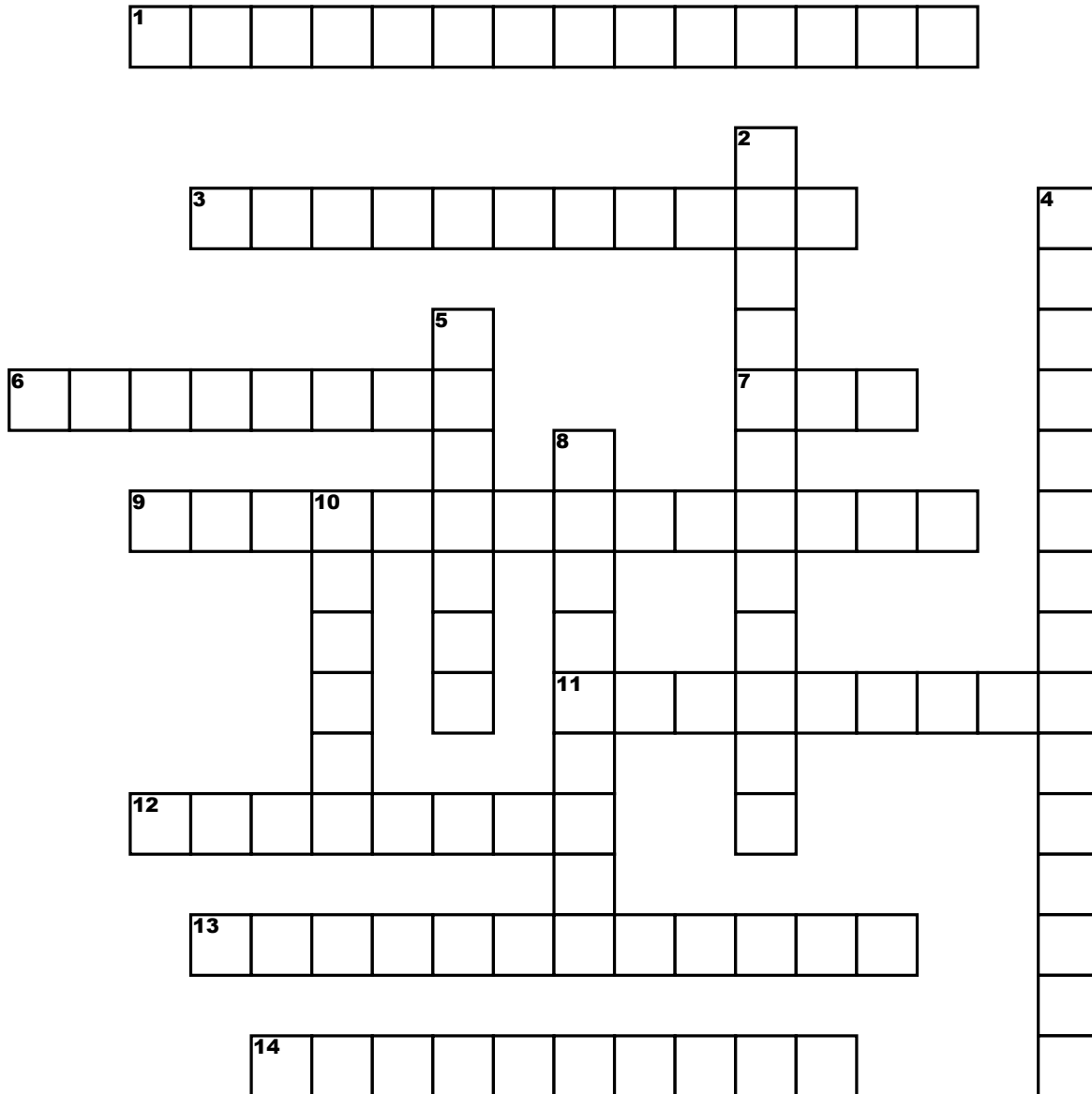


Rock The Vote Vocabulary
