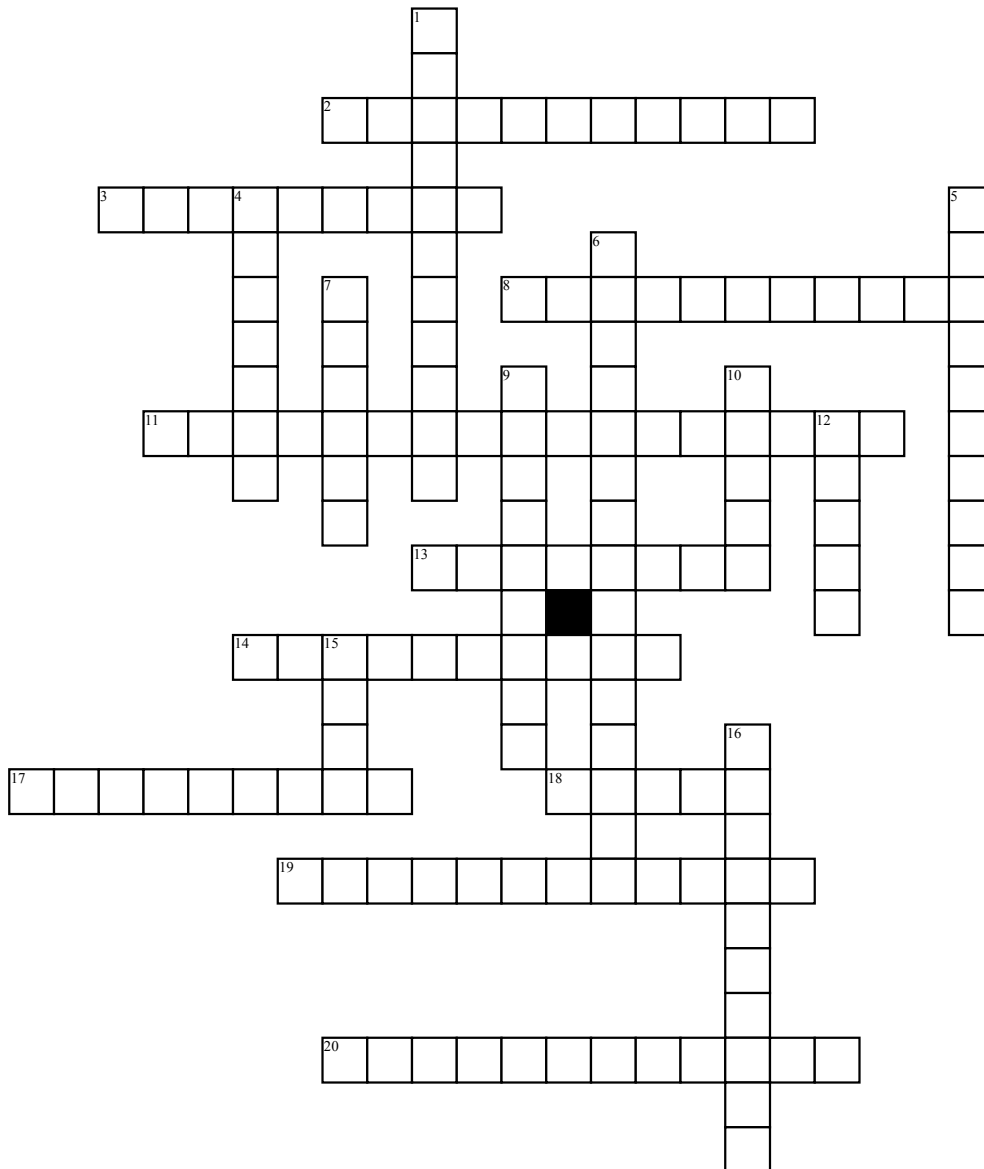


Elements of a Story
