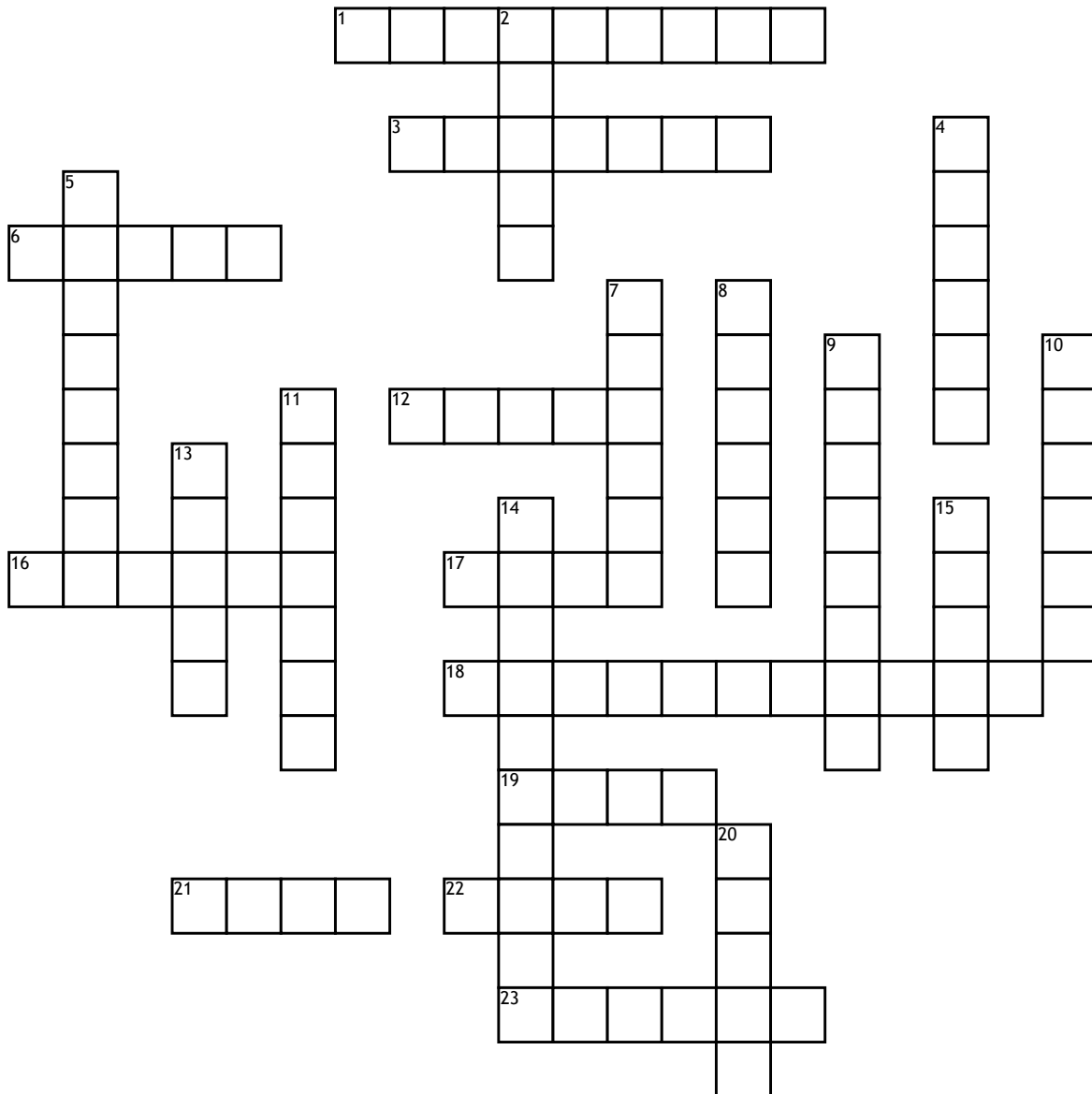

- 1. The feathers covering the ears.
- 3. The part of the foot that the animal walks on.
- 6. The hind limb extending from the rump to the hock.
- 12. The upper joint of the front leg just below the shoulder.
- 16. The transparent layer permanently covering the eye that serves as the eyelid for snakes
- 17. The upper rounded part of the hindquarter (also called the croup)
- 18. A ring encircling the eye of many birds.
- 19. The tarsal joint or large joint halfway up the hind limb.
- 21. The back of the neck.

- 22. The web of skin supported with the bone or cartilage rods that enable a fish to move through the water.
- 23. Extensions of epidermal layer of skin that have been modified to provide protection. (fish and reptiles may have some type of scales.)

Down

- 2. The topmost part of the head.
- 4. epidermal scales found on turtles
- 5. The part of an animal's body just above the elbow of the foreleg.
- 7. The loose fold of skin under the chin of an animal, most prominent in female rabbits.
- 8. The projecting jaw that contains the nose and mouth in some animals.
- 9. The long projecting hairs or bristles growing near the mouth of an animal.

- 10. The joint next above the hock in the hind leg of a four footed animal.
- 11. The tip of the nose that may be sensitive and useful for investigating food, water, or unfamiliar objects. (called nose leather in cats)
- 13. The mayor organ of the respiratory system of fish that allows them to breathe without lungs.
- 14. The longer, coarse hairs above the shorter under-fur of an animal that protects the animal and under -fur from rain and cold.
- 15. The fleshy part of the side between the ribs and the rump (croup)
- 20. The fleshy side of the side of the face below the eye and above and to the side of the mouth
